

The Buddy System

When I was a boy and taking swimming lessons at the local Boy Scout camp, we were taught to use the "Buddy System." The practice was simple and fundamental, always take a partner with you and look after each other when participating in outdoor or water activities. It taught us accountability, responsibility, and made sure we would stay safe while enjoying life's adventures. The buddy system has been adapted and used in many aspects of life and by various organizations like the military and our schools.

Unfortunately, one area that we may fail to use the buddy system is within our own congregations of the Lord's church. For some strange reason, we seem to think we are invading each other's privacy, being too pushy, or meddling in another's business if we attempt to watch out for each other's spiritual welfare. Nothing could be farther from the truth. The concept of the buddy system is found in the ancient wisdom of God. Consider the creation account, "And the Lord God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him." (Genesis 2:18) From the wisdom writings of Solomon we learn that "two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, for he has no one to help him up." (Eccles. 4:9–10) When Jesus sent out His disciples, He sent them two by two. (Luke 10:1)

If we will but take a few of the key principles of the buddy system and practice them in the church, we will see a renewed enthusiasm to truly "love one another."

- **Companionship** Get a buddy, make a friend to assure that no one is alone. (*Acts 2:44-47*)
- Accountability Buddies are responsible for each other's well-being. (Romans 15:1-2; Philippians 2:4)
- **Safety** There is safety in numbers. The predator looks for the lone and weak wanderer. (1 Peter 5:8-9)
- Stay Together If a buddy wanders off, go and get them. (Gal. 6:1-2; James 5:19-20)
