community.

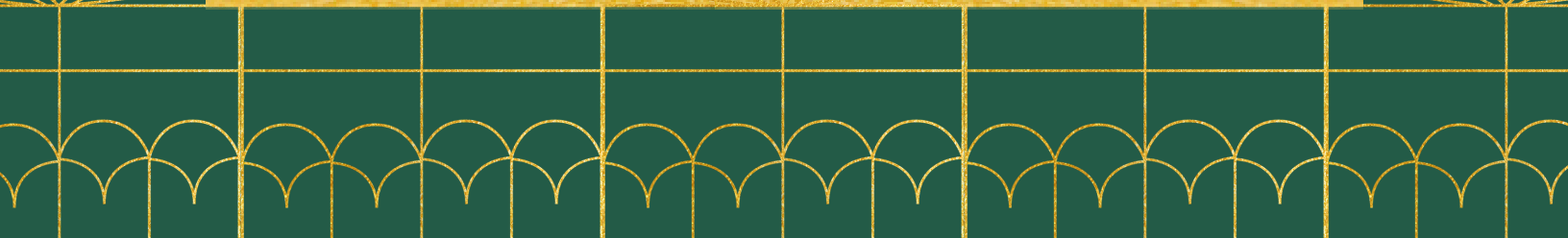
Parents and guardians, the support

enriches our educational endeavors.

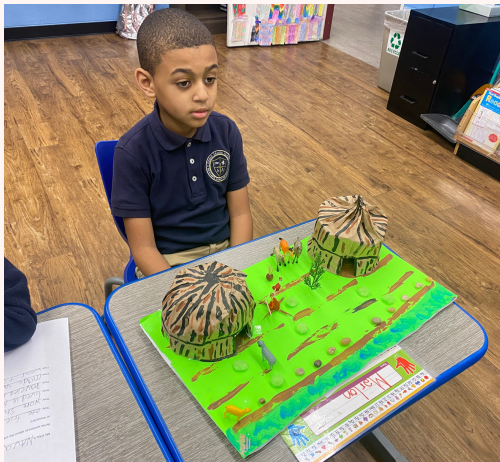
As we embrace the holiday season,
