1) Who can participate in this competition?

- ✓ The competition is open to students currently studying in **Nursery, KG to Grade 12** who are passionate about painting.
- ✓ Only **registered participants** will be allowed to take part in the competition.
- ✓ Students who do not complete the **registration fee payment** will not be permitted to participate.

2) What are the various Categories for the competition?

- ✓ Category A - Nursery & KG (Coloring Only)
- ✓ Category B - Grade 1, 2 & 3
- ✓ Category C - Grade 4, 5 & 6
- ✓ Category D - Grade 7, 8 & 9
- ✓ Category E - Grade 10, 11 & 12

3) Date and Time for various Categories?

Date: 14th November, 2026 (Saturday)

- ✓ Category A (Nursery & KG): 12 noon to 12.45 pm, 2.00 pm to 2.45 pm IST
- ✓ Category B (Grade 1, 2 & 3): 4.00 pm to 5.00 pm IST
- ✓ Category C (Grade 4, 5 & 6): 6 pm to 7.30 pm IST
- ✓ Category D (Grade 7, 8 & 9): 6 pm to 7.30 pm IST
- ✓ Category E (Grade 10, 11 & 12): 6 pm to 7.30 pm IST

Please note the above timings are in Indian Standard Time. You need to convert to your time zone if participating from any other nation apart from India.

The above is an indicative timing. Any changes to above will be informed to you by email.

4) How to register?

- Click on the Registration Payment Link (for Indian Resident Student) or Registration Payment Link (for International Student) as per your geographic location.
- Fill in the registration form and pay the registration fees (Rs. 300 for Indian Resident Participants. AED 30 / USD 5 / Euro 5 for International Participants (Non-Refundable).
- Once you complete the registration process, you will receive a payment receipt. Your payment ID will be your registration number.

5) Is there a dress code?

- ✓ There is no dress code for the competition. Participants may wear any comfortable attire of their choice.

6) Who do I contact for any query or clarification?

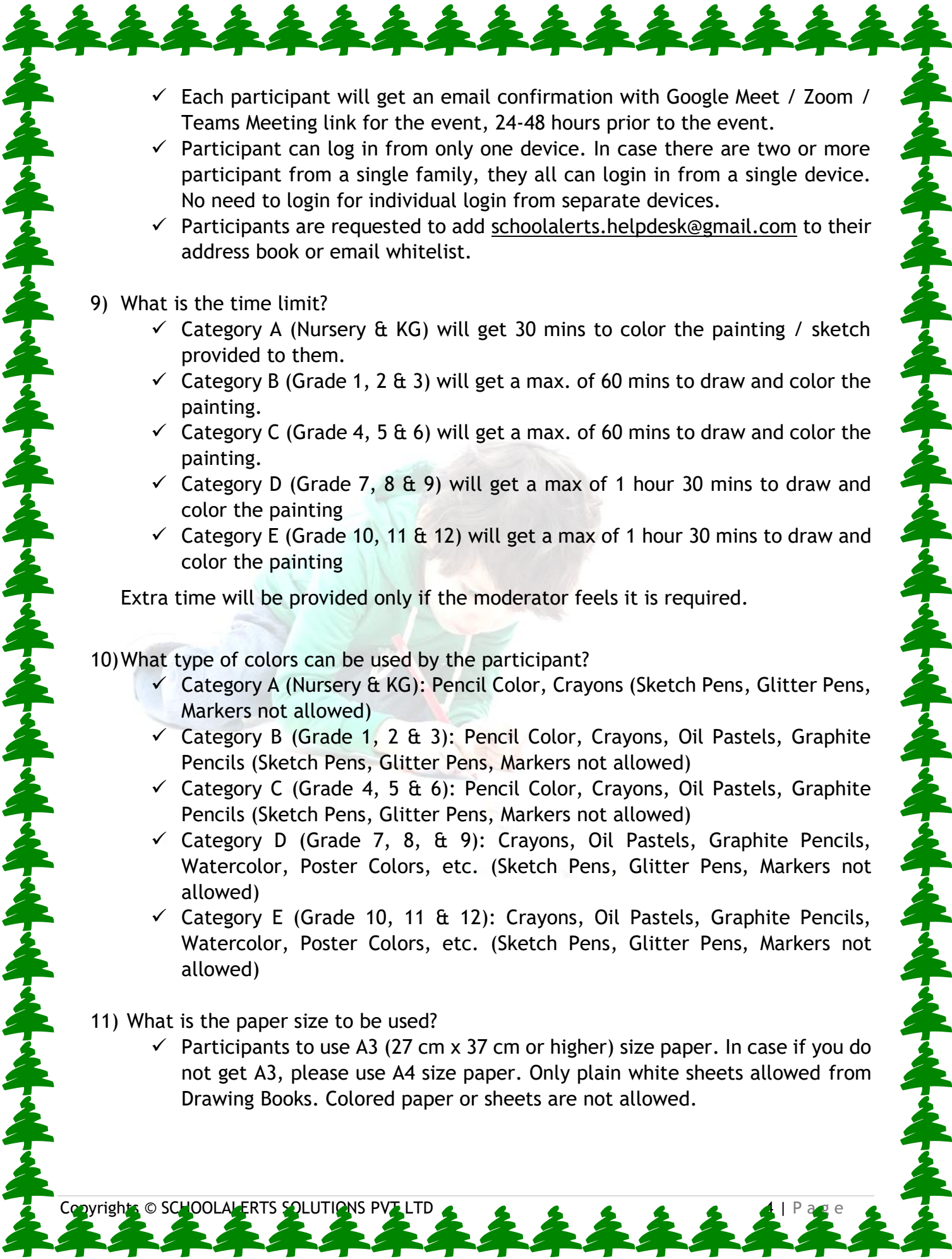
- ✓ For any queries, you may email us at schoolalerts.helpdesk@gmail.com. We aim to respond within **48 hours** of receiving your query.
- ✓ As per company policy, **phone calls will not be entertained after the commencement of the event**, to ensure a fair and unbiased evaluation process without external interference.
- ✓ **Email remains the primary and most appropriate mode of communication** for all queries.
- ✓ Queries raised up to **48 hours prior to the event** will be addressed.

7) What are the Prizes? When will I receive it if I am the winner?

- ✓ Each category will have First, Second, and Third prizes in the form of cash rewards or e-vouchers/gifts:
 - First Prize: ₹1000 or equivalent
 - Second Prize: ₹750 or equivalent
 - Third Prize: ₹500 or equivalent
 - Judges may decide to give away many other prizes worth ₹10,000 or more depending on entries received.
- ✓ In case of multiple winners for the same position, the prize amount will be distributed equally among the winners.
- ✓ Prizes are typically disbursed within one month from the date of result declaration.
- ✓ All participants will receive a Participation E-Certificate.
- ✓ Winners will receive an E-Certificate with their rank mentioned.
- ✓ All E-Certificates and E-Vouchers will be sent via email within 30 days from the date of result declaration.

8) How do I participate?

- ✓ Like our Facebook / Instagram page
- ✓ It will be a LIVE drawing competition
- ✓ For Category A (Nursery & KG) participants, we will be sharing a sketch 2-4 hours prior to the event which needs to be colored by them. Participants will need to take a printout or get it sketched from their parents. Participant will get 30-45 mins for coloring.
- ✓ For all other categories, Topic will be given “On-the-Spot”.

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- ✓ Each participant will get an email confirmation with Google Meet / Zoom / Teams Meeting link for the event, 24-48 hours prior to the event.
 - ✓ Participant can log in from only one device. In case there are two or more participant from a single family, they all can login in from a single device. No need to login for individual login from separate devices.
 - ✓ Participants are requested to add schoolalerts.helpdesk@gmail.com to their address book or email whitelist.

9) What is the time limit?

- ✓ Category A (Nursery & KG) will get 30 mins to color the painting / sketch provided to them.
- ✓ Category B (Grade 1, 2 & 3) will get a max. of 60 mins to draw and color the painting.
- ✓ Category C (Grade 4, 5 & 6) will get a max. of 60 mins to draw and color the painting.
- ✓ Category D (Grade 7, 8 & 9) will get a max of 1 hour 30 mins to draw and color the painting
- ✓ Category E (Grade 10, 11 & 12) will get a max of 1 hour 30 mins to draw and color the painting

Extra time will be provided only if the moderator feels it is required.

10) What type of colors can be used by the participant?

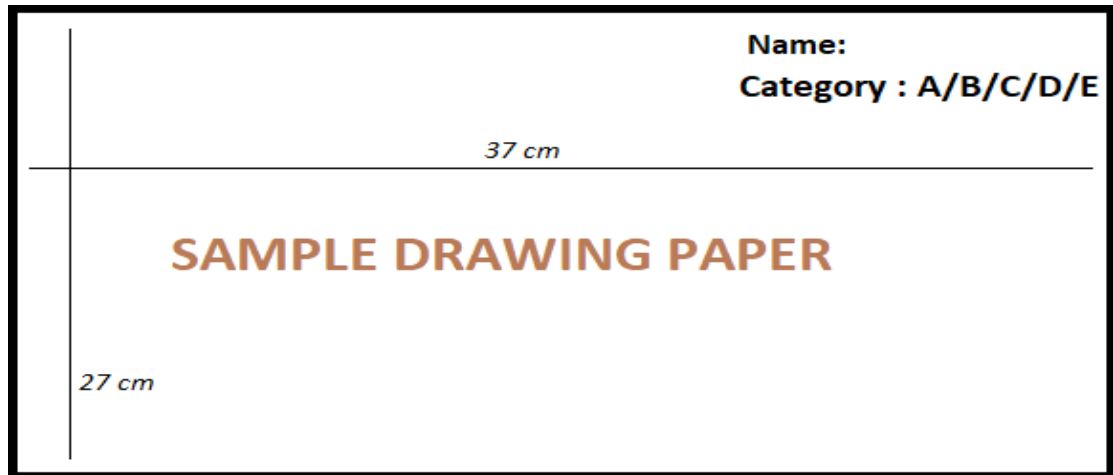
- ✓ Category A (Nursery & KG): Pencil Color, Crayons (Sketch Pens, Glitter Pens, Markers not allowed)
- ✓ Category B (Grade 1, 2 & 3): Pencil Color, Crayons, Oil Pastels, Graphite Pencils (Sketch Pens, Glitter Pens, Markers not allowed)
- ✓ Category C (Grade 4, 5 & 6): Pencil Color, Crayons, Oil Pastels, Graphite Pencils (Sketch Pens, Glitter Pens, Markers not allowed)
- ✓ Category D (Grade 7, 8, & 9): Crayons, Oil Pastels, Graphite Pencils, Watercolor, Poster Colors, etc. (Sketch Pens, Glitter Pens, Markers not allowed)
- ✓ Category E (Grade 10, 11 & 12): Crayons, Oil Pastels, Graphite Pencils, Watercolor, Poster Colors, etc. (Sketch Pens, Glitter Pens, Markers not allowed)

11) What is the paper size to be used?

- ✓ Participants to use A3 (27 cm x 37 cm or higher) size paper. In case if you do not get A3, please use A4 size paper. Only plain white sheets allowed from Drawing Books. Colored paper or sheets are not allowed.

12) How to submit the painting?

- ✓ The Paper should have a border drawn on all four sides.
- ✓ Write your name and Category on the Right-Hand Side Corner by Black or Blue Sketch Pen or Ball-point Pen.



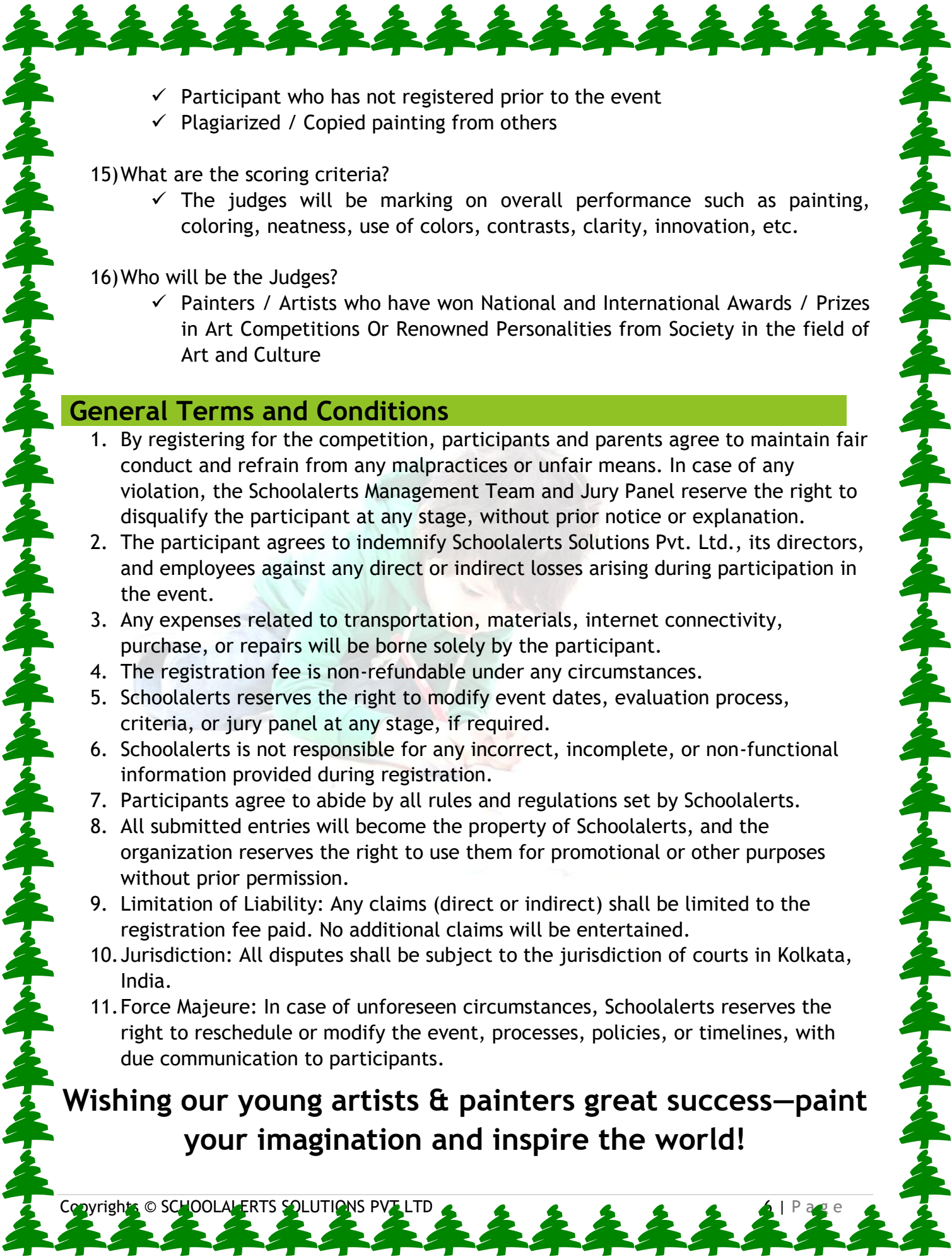
- ✓ All completed entries (only from registered participants) to be shared by WhatsApp to +91 9903005685 or email to helpdesk@schoolalerts.in within 10 mins from the end of their respective session. Any further delay may result in a disqualification and no requests will be entertained.
- ✓ A confirmation on receipt of the painting will be shared within 24-48 hours. In case you do not receive a confirmation, please get in touch with us immediately, after 48 hours from the end of the event. Non-submission of entries may result in disqualification
- ✓ No hard copies need to be sent to us. Only if the participant's entry is shortlisted for Top 3, may we ask you to courier the painting within 10 days of such a request.

13) Role of Parent / Guardian?

- ✓ Parents of participants till Grade 3 can explain the topic to their kid/s but no help whatsoever is to be provided to them for their painting / artwork. In case of ambiguity, Judges / Schoolalerts administration may disqualify any entry, without giving any reasons.

14) Reason for Disqualification may include the followings but not limited to:

- ✓ Participant did not draw as per the Topic
- ✓ Incomplete submission or Use of material/s not permitted
- ✓ Old schoolwork / drawing assignment/ artwork submitted, which may be on same topic but drawn for some other purpose
- ✓ Parents/external help in the artwork
- ✓ Painting not submitted

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- ✓ Participant who has not registered prior to the event
 - ✓ Plagiarized / Copied painting from others

15) What are the scoring criteria?

- ✓ The judges will be marking on overall performance such as painting, coloring, neatness, use of colors, contrasts, clarity, innovation, etc.

16) Who will be the Judges?

- ✓ Painters / Artists who have won National and International Awards / Prizes in Art Competitions Or Renowned Personalities from Society in the field of Art and Culture
