FAQS ON ENGLISH LANGUAGE CLASSES

- 1. Who can join the class?
 - Any student of Grade 1 to Grade 4 from any country or city can join the classes.
- 2. What will be the frequency of classes?
 - There will be 2 classes per week for one hour each. A total of 8 classes in a month. The curriculum can be completed in 3 months.
- 3. What are the charges per month or per class?
 - ➤ We charge Rs. 250 per class. Hence, for 8 classes in a month, the charges will be Rs. 2,000. Total Course Fees will be Rs. 6000 for 24 Classes. Fees once paid is completely non-refundable.
- 4. Who will be teaching my ward?
 - Our faculties are School Teachers from renowned schools in India and working professionals who have very good command over English Language.
- 5. Is there any way I can continue the classes for a duration of 1 year?
 - Yes, we can curate schedule for you in case you are interested in a longer duration course. The course fee will be shared with you along the curriculum separately, upon receipt of such request.
- 6. I am interested in taking up the course but will like to take a demo session. Can Schoolalerts arrange for a demo session?
 - Yes, surely. You can let us know and we will be happy to arrange the same for you and other students. The nearest date and time of the demo session will be shared with you, once the same is finalized.
- 7. Which Platform is used for Online Classes?
 - We prefer Zoom Meeting for various classes we offer. We also use Google Meet at times, depending on the requirement and technical feasibility.
- 8. Can I invite my friends and relatives of same age group for the demo session?
 - Yes, surely. You can ask your friends to join the demo class if they wish to enrol with us. Guests are only permitted in the Demo session.



- 9. I have a brother / sister who would also like to join. Do you have any sibling discount?
 - Yes, we have. Please get in touch with our team and they will help you with the same.
- 10. What if I miss any classes due to school examination / family trip / family function, etc.?
 - Do not worry at all. We understand that there may be other commitments at times. We will provide you with the entire class recording and study content (if any) in case of absenteeism.
- 11. Will it be 1:1 class or in Batches?
 - ➤ It will be in Batches of around 6-10 students. The maximum size will be limited to 8-10 students. We believer students learn faster in peer learning / batches.
- 12. What will be the timings and the duration of each class?
 - The classes will be held twice in a week for 60 mins on each day. The classes will be held in between 3 pm to 5 pm Indian Standard Time (IST). Please convert the same to your respective time zone.
- 13. Will there be Homework or Assignments to be done after the class?
 - Yes, the teacher will be giving you assignments from time to time and specify the submission duration. You will need to complete the homework / assignment and submit it.
- 14. Where do I have to submit the homework or assignment?
 - We will be creating a WhatsApp group for all the registered participants. You can drop your homework / assignment in that group.
- 15. Will there be a Coordinator from Schoolalerts to help us with operational issues?
 - Yes, we will assign a Coordinator from our side who will be responsible for all issues, coordination between faculties and you.
- 16. Will there be any books to follow or buy? Will Schoolalerts provide the study
 - Schoolalerts will provide the basic study material (soft copies only) of classworks. We will also share video recordings of the classes (View Only format). In case the faculty suggests any book/s, the participant may have to buy it separately.



- 17. What will be the curriculum of the classes?
 - ➤ The curriculum for Grade 1 & 2; Grade 3 & 4 is given below for your reference. The faculty may change the same depending on the capability of the children in a particular batch.
- 18. Will there be any examination at the end of the curriculum?
 - Yes, there will be Oral and Written / Multiple Choice Question examination at the end of the session.
- 19. Will we get any certificate after completion of the course?
 - Yes, you will get a Participation e-Certificate from Schoolalerts.
- 20. I have too much of pressure of school studies and cocurricular activities, want to drop off in middle of the course. Can I get a refund?
 - The fees paid is completely non-refundable since the seat is blocked for you for the entire duration of the course. There will be no refund except for medical reason. Student will have to produce relevant medical certificates if he/she aborts classes due to health issues.
- 21. When will classes/batches begin?
 - The batches will begin from end of September 2021.
- 22. What stationery are required for the classes?
 - We advise participants to keep one separate notebook for such courses. Pen / Pencil and other stationery can be used as per the comfort of the participant.
- 23. Do we need to wear school uniforms for these classes?
 - No, school uniform is not required. Participants can wear any comfortable clothes.

- 3. Only paid registrants can take up the course and no siblings or parents will be allowed until registered. Participant can login only from one device. Login from more than one device is not allowed. Participants are requested to check their audio and video before the session timings and not during the session.
- 4. The participant indemnifies Schoolalerts Solutions Pvt. Ltd., its Directors and employees of any direct or indirect losses which may arise or be incurred by the student during participation or course of the event.
- 5. Any cost involved in transportation, purchase, repair, internet connectivity, etc. will have to be borne by the participant. Schoolalerts will not be responsible for any additional cost incurred by the student for participating in the course.
- 6. The course fee once paid is non-refundable.
- 7. Only in case of medical exigencies and upon production of necessary documents, the fees will be refunded after necessary adjustments depending on the number of classes attended. A Cancellation fees of Rs. 500 will be deducted from the refund. For example, if a participant has completed two sessions and then applies for cancellation, the amount deductible will be Rs. 1000. (Rs. 250 x 2 completed session + Cancellation Fee of Rs. 500). - 12. Any assignment given needs to be submitted in PDF format within the time limit specified by the Instructor / Teacher / Moderator.
