FAQs

- 1) Who can participate in this Summer/Winter camp?
 - ✓ The course is open to students currently studying in Grade 3 to Grade 12 who are passionate about learning a new language.
 - ✓ Only registered participants will be allowed to attend the Summer/Winter Camp.
 - ✓ Students who do not complete the registration fee payment will not be permitted to participate.
 - ✓ Classes will be conducted online via platforms such as Zoom, Google Meet, or other similar applications.

- 2) What are the foreign languages courses being offered?
 - ✓ French Or
 - ✓ German Or
 - ✓ Spanish

- 3) What are the various courses being offered?
 - ✓ ***Beginner's Level 1 Course – Designed for freshers with no prior knowledge of the language.***
 - ✓ ***Beginner's Level 2 Course – Suitable for participants who already have a basic understanding of the language. (Participants are advised to refer to the Level 1 and Level 2 curriculum before selecting the appropriate course.)***
 - ✓ ***Intermediate Level 1 Course – Intended for participants who have completed Beginner's Level 1 and Level 2 (from any recognized educational institute).***
 - i. Please note: No revision sessions will be conducted in this level.***
 - ii. If a participant is enrolled in an incorrect level or does not meet the eligibility criteria, they will be shifted to the Beginner's level course.***
 - iii. No refunds will be provided in such cases.***
 - iv. Participants may still choose to continue in the Intermediate course; however, Schoolalerts will not provide revision support in such situations.***

- 4) What are the various session timings for the language classes?
 - ✓ The courses will run from **May 2026 to July 2026**, with **2-3 classes per week** (total of **10 classes per month**).
 - ✓ **Morning Weekday Batch (Monday to Friday):** Each session will be approx. **45 minutes**, scheduled between **10:30 AM to 2:00 PM IST**.

- ✓ **Evening Weekday Batch (Monday to Friday):** Each session will be approx. **45 minutes**, scheduled between **5:00 PM to 8:30 PM IST**.
- ✓ **Weekend Batch (Saturday & Sunday):** Each session will be approx. **60 minutes**.
- ✓ **A combination of weekday and weekend sessions** may be offered, subject to availability.
- ✓ Any updates or changes to the schedule will be **communicated via email**.

5) Is this course completely online? On what platform?

- ✓ The course will be conducted **online** via the **Zoom platform / Google Meet / Teams / Similar Platform**

6) What will be the batch size?

- ✓ Each batch will typically consist of 8–10 students (maximum), depending on the number of registrations received.
- ✓ We aim to optimize batch sizes to ensure that every participant receives personalized attention from the trainer/teacher.

7) What is the cost of the complete course?

For Beginner's Course Level 1:

- ✓ ₹ 2000 / ₹ 2500 per month for Indian Resident Participant depending on the date of registration OR
AED 200 / AED 250 per month for Middle East Participants from UAE, Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Kuwait and other countries depending on the date of registration

For Beginner's Course Level 2:

- ✓ ₹ 2000 / ₹ 2500 per month for Indian Resident Participant depending on the date of registration OR
AED 200 / AED 250 per month for Middle East Participants from UAE, Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Kuwait and other countries depending on the date of registration

For Intermediate Course Level 1:

- ✓ ₹ 2500 / ₹ 3000 per month for Indian Resident Participant depending on the date of registration OR
AED 250 / AED 300 per month for Middle East Participant from UAE, Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain and other countries depending on the date of registration

9) Is there a dress code?

11) In case of absenteeism, can I get a complimentary class?

- ✓ No. Live session recordings will be made available. Each session will be recorded and may be uploaded on social media platforms. The recording link will be shared with absentees for later viewing; however, access will be available only for a **limited period**.
- ✓ In case of missed sessions, we may try to accommodate participants in **parallel sessions covering the same content**, subject to **seat availability**. Please note that this is **not guaranteed**.

12) What will be the primary mode of communication?

- ✓ The **primary mode of communication** will be via email. Participants are requested to add **schoolalerts.helpdesk@gmail.com** and **helpdesk@schoolalerts.in** to their address book.
- ✓ A **secondary mode of communication** will be WhatsApp. Participants/parents are advised to regularly check their **Junk/Spam folders** for any important updates.
- ✓ **Online Class details** are typically shared **2 days prior** to the commencement of sessions.

13) I had registered thinking I would be taking up the course from home, but the family decided to go on a vacation later. What can I do?

- ✓ If cancellation is requested **10 days or more before the course start date**, a **credit note of 90%** of the amount paid will be issued. The remaining **10% will be deducted** as cancellation charges. *(No cash refunds.)*
- ✓ If cancellation is requested **between 5 to 10 days before the course start date**, a **credit note of 50%** of the amount paid will be issued. *(No cash refunds.)*
- ✓ If cancellation is requested **within 5 days before the course start date**, a **credit note of 25%** of the amount paid will be issued. *(No cash refunds.)*
- ✓ If cancellation is requested **on the day of the course start**, a **credit note of 10%** of the amount paid will be issued. *(No cash refunds.)*
- ✓ If cancellation is requested **on or after the course start date**, **no credit note or refund** will be provided.
- ✓ Credit notes can be used to enroll in **any other course(s) or competition(s)** offered by Schoolalerts, up to the eligible value.

 - Login is restricted to **one device per participant**.
 - Participants must ensure their **audio and video** are functional prior to the session.
4. The participant agrees to **indemnify Schoolalerts**, its directors, and employees against any direct or indirect losses arising during participation in the course.
5. Any expenses related to **devices, internet connectivity, transportation, purchase, or repairs** will be borne solely by the participant.

9. Post commencement, session timings may be **mutually agreed** between the instructor and participants. Otherwise, the originally selected schedule will remain applicable.
