FAQs

- 1) Who can participate in this Winter camp?
 - ✓ Any student presently studying in Grade 3 to Grade 12 and who is passionate about learning new language. Only registered participants will be allowed in the winter camp. Students who do not pay registration fee will not be allowed to participate. Classes will be conducted online on Zoom or Google Meet platform.
- 2) What are the foreign languages courses being offered?
 - ✓ French Or
 - ✓ German Or
 - ✓ Spanish
- 3) What are the various courses being offered?
 - ✓ ***Beginner's Level 1 Course for freshers***
 - ✓ ***Beginner's Level 2 Course for participants who know the basics (Please refer to the Beginner's Level 1 Curriculum and Beginner's Level 2 Curriculum and decide which one you want to pursue)***
 - ✓ ***Intermediate Level 1 Course for participants who know or have completed Level 1 and Level 2 from any educational institute. (There will be no revision classes here). In case you have enrolled wrongly / not up to the requirement of Intermediate Level Class, we will shift you to the Beginner's level course. There is no refund in such cases. However, continuing the Intermediate Course still, will be participant's decision and Schoolalerts will not be able to provide revision cases for such cases.***
- 4) What is the various session timing for the language classes?
 - ✓ The courses will begin from Mid-December 2022 to Mid-January 2023 (Morning or Evening Batch). Please let us know your preference in the registration form.
 - ✓ Morning Batch timing will be One hour in between 10 am to 12 noon IST;
 - ✓ Evening Batch timing will be one hour in between 5 pm to 7 pm IST.
 - ✓ Any changes to above will be informed to you by email.
- 5) Is this course completely online? On what platform?
 - ✓ The course is an Online Course, which will be conducted on Zoom platform.

6) What will be a batch size?

- ✓ A typical batch will be of 10-12 students at max, depending on number of registrations received. We will try to optimize it to the best so that each can get personal attention from the trainer/teacher.

7) What is the cost of the complete course?

For Intermediate Course Level 2 (For those who have completed Level 1 during Summers or other who have some background learning till Level 1):

- ✓ Rs. 4000
OR
AED 300 for Middle East Participant from UAE, Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain and other countries.

- ✓ No request for discounts will be entertained.

8) How to register?

9) Is there a dress code?

11) In case of absenteeism, can I get a complimentary class?

- ✓ No. However, each of the session will be recorded and the recording will be uploaded on social media. The link to the recording will be shared with the absentees so that they can consume it at their leisure. The recording will be available only for a limited timeframe.
- ✓ In case there are any parallel session with same content, we will try to accommodate you for the missed session. But it is non-committal and only if there are available seats.

12) What will be the primary mode of communication?

Secondary mode of communication will be WhatsApp. We request participants / parents to keep on checking their Junk / Spam folder. 13) I had registered thinking I will be taking up the course from home but the family decided to go on a vacation later. What can I do?

- ✓ If you inform us about the same on or before 5th December 2022, you will be given a credit note of the amount paid. You can take up any other class / classes with us worth 90% the amount paid. 10% of the amount will be forfeited toward cancellation charges. No cash refunds.
- ✓ If you inform us about the same after 5th December 2022 or before 10th December 2022, you will be given a credit note of 50% of the amount paid. You can utilize the credit note for taking up any other classes with us worth 50% of amount paid. No cash refunds.
- ✓ If you inform us about the same after 10th December 2022 but on or before 14th December 2022, you will be given a credit note of 25% of the amount paid. You can utilize the credit note for taking up any other classes with us worth 25% of the amount paid. No cash refunds.
- ✓ If you inform us after 14th December 2022, you will be given a credit note of 10% of the amount paid. You can utilize the credit note for taking up any other classes/competition with us worth 10% of the amount paid. No cash refunds.
- ✓ If you inform us on or after 15th December 2022, no credit note will be provided. No cash refunds.

14) When will I receive my e-Certificate?

- ✓ E-Certificates will be emailed to you within 15-20 days from the end of your course depending on the score attained in the MCQ or Written exam.

Rules and Regulation

- 1) Schoolalerts is organizing the sessions in partnership with Teachers / Associations. The faculties will be provided by the partner. In case of any issues, Schoolalerts will change partners as and when required to provide the best services to our participants.
- 2) By registering for the course, the students, and parents pledge to participate in the fairest manner and assure not to adopt any malpractices or unfair means.
- 3) Only paid registrants can take up the course and no siblings or parents will be allowed. Participant can login only from one device. Login from more than one device is not allowed. Participants are requested to check their audio and video before the session timings and not during the session.
- 4) The participant indemnifies Schoolalerts Solutions Pvt. Ltd., its Directors and employees of any direct or indirect losses which may arise or be incurred by the student during participation or course of the event.
- 5) Any cost involved in transportation, purchase, repair, internet connectivity, etc. will have to be borne by the participant. Schoolalerts will not be responsible for any additional cost incurred by the student for participating in the course.
- 6) The course fee once paid is non-refundable.
- 7) Only in case of medical exigencies and upon production of necessary documents, the fees will be refunded after necessary adjustments depending on the number of classes attended. A Cancellation fees of Rs. 500 or AED 50 will be deducted from the refund. For example, if a participant has completed two sessions and then applies for cancellation, the amount deductible will be Rs. 900 or equivalent calculated in other currency. (Rs. 200 x 2 completed session + Cancellation Fee of Rs. 500). An application in written with necessary supporting should be emailed to us at schoolalerts.helpdesk@gmail.com.
- 8) No refund or cancellation request will be entertained in case of any absenteeism or reason except for Medical.
- 9) Post the start of the course, the timings may be decided by the instructor and students, mutually, depending on their comfort. Else, the timings given by us and selected by the participant while registering, will stand as-is for your session.
- 10) Schoolalerts takes no responsibility in case any of the details provided in the registration form by the participant / student / parent is fake, non-operational or wrong.
- 11) The participant always agrees to abide by all rules and regulations of Schoolalerts.
- 12) Any assignment given needs to be submitted in PDF format within the time limit specified by the Instructor / Teacher / Moderator.
- 13) All assessments will be taken up as per the schedule provided by the Instructor / Teacher / Moderator.

- 14) In case of network issue or absenteeism at participant's end, the Instructor / Teacher / Moderator will wait for a few mins and then go ahead with the session. Such participants can go through the recorded session at leisure.
- 15) Limitation of Liability: Any claim whatsoever, direct or indirect, will be limited to the registration fees paid by the participant. Schoolalerts liability will be restricted to the course fee received from the participant only. No other claims will be entertained.
