- ✓ Any student currently studying in Grade 3 to Grade 11 may participate.
- ✓ Only registered participants will be allowed to participate.
- ✓ Students who do not pay the registration fee will not be permitted.
- ✓ Participation is encouraged for students willing to learn and enjoy the event.

2) What are the various Categories for the competition?

- ✓ Grade 3 & 4
- ✓ Grade 5 & 6
- ✓ Grade 7 & 8
- ✓ Grade 9, 10 & 11

3) How many rounds will be there?

- ✓ **Qualifying Round:** (June 2026)
- ✓ **Finale with Shortlisted students:** (July 2026) (Tentative).

- 5) What is the last date of registration? Are the seats limited?
- ✓ Last date: **30th May, 8:00 PM IST** (*unless extended*)
 - ✓ Approximate capacity: **800-1000 participants**
 - ✓ Seats are allotted on a **First Come, First Served** basis
 - ✓ Registration may close early if seats are filled
 - ✓ Schoolalerts reserves the right to reopen registration if capacity permits

- 6) When will the timings be shared with us?
- ✓ Participants may select preference for 1st Half / 2nd Half of the Day
 - ✓ Exact session timings will be shared after registration closes
 - ✓ Zoom/Meeting link will be emailed 48 hours prior to scheduled session
 - ✓ Details may also be shared via WhatsApp on registered mobile number

- 7) Is there a dress code?
- ✓ There is no dress code
 - ✓ Participants can wear any comfortable outfit

- 9) What are the Prizes? When will I receive it if I am the winner?

- ✓ **Total Prize Pool: ₹20,000**
- ✓ For each category:
 - **1st Prize:** ₹ 1000 / equivalent other currency e-Voucher
 - **2nd Prize:** ₹ 900 or equivalent other currency e-Voucher
 - **3rd Prize:** ₹ 800 or equivalent other currency e-Voucher
- ✓ Additional awards may include:

10) What is the registration, Fee?

- ✓ Indian Resident School Students: **₹ 350** (Rupees Three Hundred Fifty Only)
- ✓ Middle East Participants (UAE, Oman, Bahrain, Qatar, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia and other Middle East countries): **AED 25** (Dirhams Twenty-Five Only)
- ✓ US, Europe and other countries Participants: **USD 10 / Euro 10** (Dollars Ten)

11) Will it be a team performance event?

- ✓ No, it is an individual competition.

12) What is the format?

- ✓ Batch Formation or Individual Performance:
 - Participants will be grouped into batches by category.
 - Each batch will have **10-15 participants**.
 - Participants may belong to different schools.
- ✓ Possible rounds include:
 - Direct Spellings
 - Fill in the Blanks
 - Identify the Picture & Spell
 - Unscramble the Word
 - Surprise Round
- ✓ Scoring Rules:
 - **1 mark** for each correct answer
 - **0 marks** for incorrect/pass
 - No negative marking
 - First answer will be treated as final
- ✓ Additional Rules:
 - Max response time generally **5 seconds** per question
 - **Top 3 scorers per batch** proceed to Finale
 - Additional Finale prep material will be shared with shortlisted students
 - There may be negative marking in higher rounds or change in scoring pattern as we proceed in the competition
 - Format may be modified by Schoolalerts if required

13) Can a child participate in a higher-Grade category?

- ✓ No
- ✓ Participants must compete only in their **current grade category**.
- ✓ Violation may lead to disqualification.

14) What is the Prep book?

- ✓ Spelling preparation document will be shared from **15th May onward**
- ✓ Most questions will come from this document
- ✓ All shared material remains the property of Schoolalerts
- ✓ **Errors and Omissions Excepted (E&OE)**

15) I came to know about the event late and hence registered late. Can I learn spellings from selected pages only?

- ✓ No
- ✓ All participants must prepare the **entire document** unless otherwise informed in writing.

16) Are participants allowed to refer to English Dictionary or any other document during the event?

- ✓ No
- ✓ Use of dictionaries, spelling documents, notes, or any other reference material is prohibited.
- ✓ Use of Google, AI tools, Voice-to-text, and other technology etc. is strictly prohibited.

17) Can participants use electronic gadgets or search engine during the event?

- ✓ No
- ✓ Mobile phones, Alexa, Google, Bing, or any search mechanism are not permitted.

18) Can parents or my siblings help to answer Questions?

- ✓ No
- ✓ No external assistance is permitted from anyone.
- ✓ Help may only be taken for operational/technical issues.

19) What are the scoring criteria?

- ✓ Rankings are based on total correct answers.
- ✓ Judges' decision will be final.
- ✓ Results may be withheld for verification if required.

20) Word of Caution:

- ✓ Any malpractice may result in immediate disqualification, including but not limited to:
 - Prompting answers by others
 - Using reference materials
 - Using gadgets/search tools
 - Using projectors/hidden devices
- ✓ Additional Mandatory Rules:
 - Audio & Video must remain ON throughout
 - Both hands must be visible on camera
 - Multiple device login is prohibited
 - Participants may be asked to close their eyes while answering
 - Earphones/Headphones are mandatory for Grade 3 and above

Schoolalerts reserves the right to disqualify any participant in case of doubt/ambiguity without providing justification.

- ✓ Moderators may include:
 - Industry Experts with strong English proficiency
 - School Teachers
 - Current / Former British Council Faculty
 - Senior Management Personnel from MNCs
