1. What is the event all about?

✓ We all may have been to our School Alumni meet some time in our lives. We must have met a few of our friends but not all. We still miss our friends from neighboring schools in the city. We may have never met our friends from these school after our school days. Also, we generally tend to attend one Alumni meet and then skip the next 5-6 until we have our friends attending the same. This event is for those who want to meet a larger group of friends whose memory has been done and dusted. Few may be there as your secret friends list. We, at Schoolalerts, want to bring back nostalgic moments for you and such group of friends.

2. What is the Plan?

✓ We begin with an Online Introductory session in January and then take it forward with a Physical Meet over Lunch / Dinner in August / September depending on the COVID Situation. We roll out the event for a complete city and ex-students from any school within that city, can enroll and join the session.

3. What are the criteria for joining this Meet?

✓ You need to be a Grade 10 or Grade 12 pass-out from any school (Private /
Government / other educational institute) from year 1995 to 2005. You will
have to submit your Grade 10 / Grade 12 Passing certificate.

4. Why do you need the Passing Certificate of Grade 10 / Grade 12?

✓ This is for verification purpose. We do not want unwanted guests to be there in the session. This will provide initial screening and ensure that we all connect in best possible way with our friends (old or new).





- 5. I attend my School's Alumni meet every year. What is the benefit of attending one more and that too, away from School?
 - ✓ We do not intend to bring distance between you and your school, but our intention is to provide you platform where you can meet not only friends from your school but your friends from other schools too.
 - ✓ For example, I did my schooling from St. Joseph's College, Kolkata and had friends in St. James School, Frank Anthony Public School, Loreto Day, Welland Gouldsmith School, Calcutta Boys School, or any other schools. Post my schooling, I have never met them in my life but have great memories with them such as bunking school together, watching movies together after school, playing cricket/other sports together, etc. which is long forgotten. We want you to remember those Good Days, Relive and Reconnect to revisit those days.
 - ✓ Along with making you feel Nostalgic, we bring an opportunity for you to network with your own batchmates. This will help you in professional as well as personal life.
- 6. What are the dates / schedule for the City-wise Alumni Meet?
 - ✓ We will be having an Online Alumni Meet City-wise as per the following schedule:
 - i. 1st Sunday of January: Kolkata
 - ii. 2nd Sunday of January: Mumbai
 - iii. 3rd Sunday of January: Delhi, NCR
 - iv. 4th Sunday of January: Bangalore
 - ✓ The Online meeting will be a prelude to the Physical Meeting. Physical Meet will be scheduled in any renowned Hotel during Aug-Oct post COVID.





- 7. What is the agenda of the Online Alumni Meeting?
 - ✓ We will give everyone 2 mins time to briefly introduce themselves, in a particular sequence and then open the house to suggest their expectation from the Physical Meet. However, we have plans of cultural activities, games and many more over Lunch / Dinner. We will also extend the invite to your Spouse and Children if you are comfortable getting them along. May not be advised, if you come looking for your old crush / boyfriends / girlfriend ౿
 - ✓ The 2 mins introduction can include the followings:
 - i. Your Name
 - ii. Your School Name and Year of Pass-Out
 - iii. Your Current Work
 - iv. Your Current Work location
 - v. What is that you miss from your school-life the most?
- 8. What are the charges for the Online Meeting and for the Physical Meet?
 - ✓ We have kept very nominal registration charges for the Online Meeting of Rs. 200 per attendee while the charges for Physical Meet will be approx. Rs. 1500 - Rs. 2000 per pax depending on the actual hotel / Banquet Hall, we book. The exact cost and other details for the Physical Meet will be shared later. In case you are out of the city and would like us to arrange logistics, we will do it for you, at a separate cost.
- 9. Why have you done it City wise and not a national event?
 - ✓ We expect much smoother interaction between city folks and a good number of turn outs, National event will be our next footstep.
- 10. Have you ever done such events in the past?
 - ✓ Schoolalerts has done numerous events for School going kids from Grade 1 to Grade 12 till now. The current team consists of Working Professionals, Postgraduate & Graduate students who have organized many such events at their workplace or College or at their educational institute such as College Fest, Annual Events, Inter-School, or Inter-College events to name a few.
