





EXPECTATIONS

on Dancers

- Dancers should be prompt for class. All students should arrive at least five minutes prior to their scheduled class time.
- Waiting until the music is finished before entering the classroom if they are late to class.
- Water bottles with closed lids are allowed in studios (water only).
- No food is allowed inside the classrooms.
- If a dancer is injured and cannot dance during class. A doctor's note will need to be provided along with updates.

02 Class Cancellation

- The Studio closely follows the Olathe School District Calendar, however, we do not close for teachers' in-service, conference days and certain holidays. Please refer to our list of important dates.
- If classes should need to be cancelled due to weather, an text will be sent out and it will be posted on our Facebook page, Instagram page and Website.
- The first snow day that affects each class will NOT be followed by a make-up lesson.
 Should a second or subsequent snow day occur for that same class, we will schedule a make-up lesson.

Missed Classes

- No credit or refund will be given for classes missed by students. We do not grant a leave of absence for students.
- Should a student miss class because of illness or other prior commitment, classes may be made-up by attending one of our other classes with prior instructor consultation as to appropriate class placement.
- If a student is unable to attend class, please log it in the SP Parent Portal to notify the teacher.
- We reserve the right to reschedule or cancel a class time for reasons of insufficient enrollment or instructors' professional discretion.



TUITION & FEES POLICIES

Tuition fees are figured according to the number of hours per week your dancer is taking. The options for The Studio tuition payments are as follows:

- **Annual Tuition Payment**: Paid on or before September 1, 2025 to get the prepayment discount.* *This discount does not apply to anything other than Tuition payment. Must be paid by cash/check.
- Monthly Auto-pay will be run on the 1st of every month from September through May.

*In the event both parents do not live in the same home, arrangements can be made to split billing and duplicate communication. Please have both parents contact Ms. Diane for more information.

- Tuition will not be prorated or refunded for missed classes regardless of the reason.
- The enrollment fee is **NON-Refundable**.
- Recital Fee is due November 1, 2025 via Auto-pay or paid in advance.
- Costume Fee is due November 1, 2025 via Auto-Pay or paid in advance.
 - Recital fee and Costume fee are NON-Refundable.
- All dancers are required to be enrolled in Auto-Pay through SP.
 - *Exceptions include those who paid the annual fees upfront or made arrangements prior to registration.
 - If your credit card expires during this time, we will reach out to you to update in the SP portal.
 - If you card fails Auto-pay fails for any reason, we will also reach out to you to update your credit card.

Other Opportunities

Choreography Packages

If your child(ren) or a family friend is interested in performing a solo, duet and/or a trio, for competition, talent show or anything else, we can help! Available styles: ballet, contemporary, tap, hip hop, jazz and musical theater.

The Solo/ Duet/ Trio Choreography package includes:

- · One two minute choreographed dance
- Two 1-hour long private lessons to learn the choreography
- One 30 minute private lesson to clean the piece
- Four 15 minute private sessions for additional clean/prep

2026 Recital Contract

Due October 1, 2025

Recital participation is NOT a requirement.

We assume you will be participating unless you notify us by October 1st. As of October 1st, you become obligated to pay the total recital fee for your child even if he/she discontinues classes.

Expectations for Participation:

- The Studio's Recital Contract is designed to ensure all children participating in the dance show will receive the same, great experience. In order to accomplish this goal, each student's parent/guardian will need to be involved and committed.
- Once we begin learning choreography in February before recital, students should not miss more than 4 weeks per dance class. It is so important that all children come to class so that we can continue to move forward with the dance.


Recital Fee Payments:

- Payment for recital fees and costume(s) is due November 1, 2025. Regardless if your child performs in the recital, the recital fee and costume fee is Non-Refundable.
- Fees will be charged through the SP portal Auto-Pay November 1, 2025 unless other arrangements with Miss Diane have been made or been paid in advance.
