7. When, roughly did the Rothschilds Arms (now a private house located at the crossroads of Buckland Road), stop being a pub?
8. Can you name two 17th century cottages in the village...there are several!
9. Did you know that The Rectory was built by subscriptions from the people of Buckland? It was! But in which century and for whom?
