

Diagonal dish cloth Patterns



Knit pattern

Crochet pattern:

Row 1: With MC, Ch 5, dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in same ch, 2dc in last ch (5 st including turning chain)

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in same dc (first dc), dc in next dc, 2dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in turning ch (8 st including turning chain)

Each row will increase by 3.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in same dc (first dc), dc in next 2 dc, 2dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in turning ch (11 st)

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in same dc (first dc), dc in next 4 dc, 2dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in turning ch (14 st)

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, dc in same dc (first dc), dc in next 5 dc, 2dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc, 2 dc in turning ch (17 st)

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in same dc (first dc), dc in next 7 dc, 2dc in next dc, dc in next 7 dc, 2 dc in turning ch (20 st)

Next rows increase by 2 each.

Row 7-11: Ch 3, turn, dc in same dc (first dc), dc across to turning ch, 2 dc in turning ch (22, 24, 26, 28, 30)

Decreasing Rows.

Row 12-16: Ch 3, turn, dc2tog, dc in each dc across to last 2 sts, dc2tog over the last dc and the turning ch (28, 26, 24, 22, 20)

Row 17-21: Ch 3, turn, dc2tog, dc in each dc across until in middle, dc2tog, dc in each dc across to last 2 sts, dc2tog over the last dc and the turning ch (17, 14, 11, 8, 5)

Make optional loop

Ch 8. Sc into first dc of last row, taking care not to twist chain. Sc into the back loop of the chain. Cut yarn. Weave end into loop.
