

Pride Slouch Hat

Based on wurm design by umschlagplatz.at



Supplies:

DK yarn

- 15 grams each of purple, blue, green, yellow, orange, red
- 100 grams of black

US 4 16" circular needles for ribbing

US 6 16" circular needles for body

US 6 DPN for decreasing rounds, optional.

Sizes small (medium/large) to fit head circumference 53 55 (55-57, 57-59) cm

Note that this hat edge is not ribbed.

Pattern

Using US 4 needles and black yarn, CO 90 (100/110). Join in the round. Place stitch marker at the beginning of the row.

Brim

Rounds 1-12: K

Round 13: P

Rounds 14-26: K

Fold at purl round with knit side facing out and purl side in. Pick up first st from cast on edge and k together with live st; repeat this for entire row making a double edged brim

Body

Setup round: K

Using US 6 needles, join purple yarn. You need not break the black yarn: you may float it, if you desire.

Inc round: [k10, m1] repeat around.

Stripe pattern

Rounds 1-10: P

Break rainbow color. Switch to black yarn.

Rounds 11-14: K

Switch to next color stripe (Purple, Blue, Green, Yellow, Orange, Red)

Round 15: K

Repeat the Stripe pattern for each color ending after the Red purl rounds.

Switch to black yarn.

Decrease rounds

Round 1: [K1, K2tog] repeat around (K excess stitches)

Round 2: K

Round 3: [K1, K2tog] repeat around (K excess stitches)

Round 4: K

Round 5-6: K2tog around (twice around)

Break yarn. Thread through remaining stitches, pull tight, and fasten off.
