### **Property Tax:**

Expense shows "Property Taxes" at \$58,883.37.

Income shows "Grant In Aid -Property Tax" of \$41,840.70 which we applied for and was granted this amount through the North Peace Community Foundation.

Total amount paid to the City in Property Tax is 17.042.67.

#### **Cathedraticum:**

15% of our income through collections and fees for service goes to the Diocese.

We do not pay cathedraticum on Building Donations.

#### Repair & Maintenance:

Repair & Maintenance expense includes the roof repair cost of \$7,388.20 and the chimney/furnace cost of \$6.0058.37. The Knights of Columbus has donated \$6,300 for the chimney/furnace.
