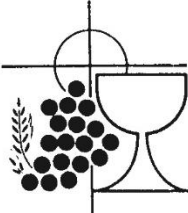

Repairs and Maintenance 2026.

Each month there is a special envelope in the Box of Collection Envelopes designated as *Repairs and Maintenance*.

We did a lot of repairs to the roofs last summer and now we continue with repairs to the roof and to the large window over the Altar that you can see from the outside.

The preliminary quotes from WL Construction for the window over the Altar is **\$25,030 plus GST.**

Four separate quotes for four other roof areas come in at **\$8, 235 plus GST, \$6,485 plus GST, \$3,500 plus GST, \$2,750 plus GST, totaling about \$49, 000.**

WL Construction emphasise that these are budgetary quotes only and, until they pull things apart, the real amounts will be based on **Time and Materials.**
