- 1. September 8/25- Femicide Letters- 40 signed letters were delivered to MP Bob Zimmer's office for September 15th opening of Parliament. Updates pending
- 2. September 18/25- Faith- Based Charities petition has been tabled for further debate. We honor our 124 signatures being a part of the 38,942 submitted to affirm the status of Epetition 6586, protecting the charitable status of faith-based contributions.
- 3. November 14/25- MAiD- Bill C-218 is scheduled for second reading on December 5/25. CWL members are submitting letters of support for Bill C-218: An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Medical Assistance in Dying) to add the exclusion: a mental disorder is not a grievous and irremediable medical condition. In March 2025 we supported the original MAiD Bill C-7 submitting 87 signed letters.
