1. September 8/25- Femicide Letters- 40 signed  
letters were delivered to MP Bob Zimmer’s  
office for September 15th opening of Parlia-  
ment. Updates pending
2. September 18/25- Faith- Based Charities peti-  
tion has been tabled for further debate.  
We honor our 124 signatures being a part of  
the 38,942 submitted to affirm the status of E-  
petition 6586, protecting the charitable status  
of faith-based contributions.
3. November 14/25- MAiD- Bill C-218 is sched-  
uled for second reading on December 5/25.  
CWL members are submitting letters of sup-  
port for Bill C-218: An Act to amend the Crimi-  
nal Code (Medical Assistance in Dying) to add  
the exclusion: a mental disorder is not a griev-  
ous and irremediable medical condition.  
In March 2025 we supported the original  
MAiD Bill C-7 submitting 87 signed letters.
