#### FOOD FOR THOUGHT

"Is this thing working?" There is the funny story of the raw army recruit standing at attention on the drill field. The drill instructor yells, "Forward, march!" And the entire ranks begin to move, all except this one raw recruit. He's still standing there at attention. So, the drill instructor strolls over to him and yells in his right ear, "Is this thing working?" "Sir, yes, sir!" the recruit yells. Then the drill instructor walks around to the other ear and

yells, "Is this thing working?" "Sir, yes, sir!" The soldier says. "Then why didn't you march when I gave the order?" #### **CWL PETITION INITIATIVES**

The CWL has 2 federal petitions to sign at the back of the Church.

The first petition is for "the protection of charitable status for pro-life and religious organizations." New recommendations would have serious and far reaching consequences for faith-based and pro-life organizations and the many services they offer to those in need.

The second petition is to prevent the expansion of MAID. New recommendations for MAID would allow advanced written requests for MAID which could be interpreted differently than intended, or be difficult to revoke later in life.
