HISTORY OF ORGANIZATION:

The organization is a charitable 501c3 non-profit.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

The non-renewable \$1000 scholarship/s *for Spring 2022* will be awarded for tuition, books, and/or fees. Scholarship/s will be deposited directly into the student's college financial account at their selected college, university, or technical school.

Arrangements will be made directly with the awarded student/s to apply the scholarship to their college financial account.

ELIGIBILITY:

- \Rightarrow Must be a Latina female resident of Weld County.
- \Rightarrow Must be a high school graduate or have a GED.
- \Rightarrow Must be a non-traditional, undergraduate student, 25 years of age or older.
- \Rightarrow Must be a full-time or part-time student with a minimum of 6 credit hours.

 \Rightarrow Must be working toward completion of a 2 or 4-year degree or vocational certificate program, at an accredited institution of higher learning in the State of Colorado.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Applications must be complete and required documents attached. *Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.*
- 2. Mandatory documentation—Attach or enclose the following:
 - a. A recent transcript, ACT/SAT scores, or an assessment test from the school the student is or will attend.
 - b. A copy of the school acceptance letter or copy of the most recent class schedule.
 - c. A copy of financial aid application FAFSA or a SAR report.
 - d. Two (2) letters of recommendation.
- 4. Scholarship recipient/s will be notified when the final determination is made. Payment processes are determined by the school attended and the Hispanic Women of Weld County.
- 5. All materials will be confidential and will not be returned.
