

Need Help Buying Groceries?

NJ SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) is New Jersey's food assistance program that can help you buy groceries.

What is SNAP?

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) issues electronic benefits that can be used like cash to purchase food. SNAP helps low-income working people, senior citizens, the disabled and others feed their families.

Who can apply?

- Any household member who is 18+ years old and has at least 5 years of residency in the United States.
- If you are undocumented with children who are American citizens, you can still apply for SNAP benefits on their behalf.
- An authorized representative who can go food shopping and use NJ SNAP benefits on behalf of your household (a friend, relative, neighbor). A SNAP household is anyone who lives and eats together.
- Must meet the qualifying income levels

What do I need to apply?

- A valid ID (i.e. driver's license, birth certificate, government ID)
- Proof of where you live (i.e. lease, rental agreement, utility bill) *Unless you are experiencing homelessness
- Proof of earned income (i.e. paystubs, employer letter, recent tax records)
- Proof of unearned income (benefits award letter)
- Proof of resources (i.e. bank statements)
- Social Security Number
- Proof of immigration status (for non-citizens)
- Proof of student status (for college students)

- You should never be asked to pay for assistance to fill out an application. There is no charge.
