- 1. <u>Crisis Hotline and Text Line: Provides immediate support through the Crisis Hotline (513-528-SAVE) and Crisis Text Line 988.</u>
- 2. <u>Harm Reduction Machine: Offers free harm reduction items like Narcan, hygiene kits, and Fentanyl Test Strips to registered users.</u>
- 3. <u>Suicide Prevention Coalition: Increase awareness and resources to help reduce the number of suicides in the county.</u>
- 4. <u>Mini-Grants: Funding innovative projects that positively impact mental health and help prevent addiction across various age groups.</u>

These initiatives are vital in providing support and resources to families, individuals, and vulnerable populations in Clermont County.
