The Clermont County Mental Health and Recovery Board (CCMHRB) plays a crucial role in supporting the community. Some of the ongoing community

engagement projects include:

1. Crisis Hotline and Text Line: Provides immediate support through the Crisis Hotline (513-528-SAVE) and Crisis Text Line 988.
2. Harm Reduction Machine: Offers free harm reduction items like Narcan, hygiene kits, and Fentanyl Test Strips to registered users.
3. Suicide Prevention Coalition: Increase awareness and resources to help reduce the number of suicides in the county.
4. Mini-Grants: Funding innovative projects that positively impact mental health and help prevent addiction across various age groups.

These initiatives are vital in providing support and resources to families, individuals, and vulnerable populations in Clermont County.
