National Awareness in September



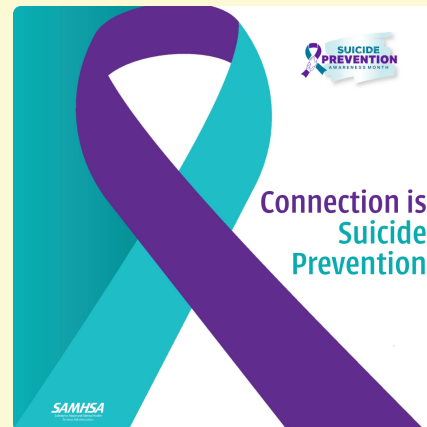
National Recovery Month
