
## Clermont County Mental Health and Recovery Board CIT Class

CCMHRB staff are gearing up for the next Crisis Intervention Team training March 30-April 3, 2026. CIT Certified Officers will have new skills to serve as a designated responder or lead officer in mental health crisis events. The CIT training will include educational lectures, site visits, role plays, consumer and family member testimonials and simulation exercises.

## Funding Opportunity Available!

In an effort to foster activities that promote improved mental health, prevent addiction or the harm associated with addiction, the Clermont County Mental Health and Recovery Board is pleased to announce an opportunity for funding.

A total of up to \$30,000 is available for programs serving Clermont County residents of any age. The maximum available funding per project is \$3,000. The grant period will be July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. Any organized group in Clermont County – with the exception of the contract agencies of the Clermont County Mental Health and Recovery Board – can apply for funding. Proposals are due no later than May 15, 2026
