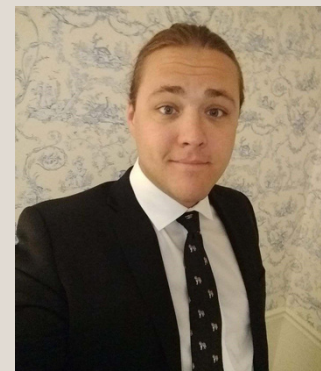
But these wins are at risk. If the TSA is not properly funded, these pay raises could be in jeopardy, and jobs could be cut.
