ACTS - Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication

Adoration: We remember to praise and honor the triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who is the Creator, Sustainer, and Redeemer of the universe. He is not confined or controlled by the thoughts or the actions of mankind, nor anything else.

For the LORD your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God, who is not partial and takes no bribe. He executes justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the sojourner, giving him food and clothing.” **Deuteronomy 10:17-18**

“O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is Your name in all the earth! You have set Your glory above the heavens.”
Psalms 8:1

“Not to us, O LORD, not to us, but to Your name give glory, for the sake of Your steadfast love and Your faithfulness! Why should the nations say, “Where is their God?” Our God is in the heavens; He does all that He pleases.” **Psalms 115:1-3**

Confession: We come before the Lord God and remember that we have trespassed against God by things we’ve done, as well as by things we didn’t do that we should’ve done. We are sinful and have fallen short of His glory. As we pray, we should look at ourselves before looking at others. We want to start by confessing that the problem begins with us.

Thanksgiving: We need to come before God with thankful hearts for what He has given us. He provides redemption for everyone who calls upon His name. “Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise! Give thanks to Him, bless His name! For the LORD is good; His steadfast love endures forever, and His faithfulness to all generations.” **Psalms 100:4-5**
