

Membership and Fees

- Membership runs from September to August
- Members joining after December will pay the remainder of the current year (prorated 7\$/month), 84\$ for a full year, and a 20\$ admin fee for all members 18+.
- Prorated Rates (January (56\$) February (49\$) March (42\$) April (35\$) May (28\$) June (21\$) July (14\$) August (7\$))
- Yearly fees \$84.00 (\$42 (18+) / \$21 (Under 17)) must be living in same household.
- Under 17 must always be accompanied by a legal guardian who is a club member.
- \$20 Admin fee for failing to renew by the 1st of October plus a Tuesday night!
- Renewed cards can be collected Tuesday nights/AGM), unless S.A.E / \$2 is provided.
- Guests are welcome. However, after 2 visits we expect them to join. Members are to ensure their guests pay a cover fee of \$5.00 which pays for insurance and submit the guest address. Members are responsible for their guest!!!
- All personal information is for executive use (club news, CFO, DNR & Insurance company) ONLY and is not given to third parties. Communications are via email, so important we always have up-to-date address.

Getting to the Range

The Hampton Rifle & Pistol Club 53 Heritage Lane Bloomfield, Kings County, NB



- Take the Bloomfield Exit 166
- Turn right at the stop sign (Saint John or Sussex)
- Less than 1 km and take the first street on left (Heritage Lane)
- Go to the end and you will see a gravel road on your right
- Follow the gravel road for 4.6 km and take a hard right
- Keep following the road, you will cross a railroad track
- You will come to our gate at 5.7Km

Gate Procedures



- The gate barrier is to be put down, do not lock the gate
- Ensure the sign states "Range in Use"
- Raise the flag

Shotgun Bay

- Shooter must engage clays from the trellis
- Shot limited to 7 1/2, 8 and 9
- Pick up your spent hulls, ammo boxes, trash
- If two or more persons on site, one must act as Range Officer
- Any exceptions to above must be authorized by an Executive Member

Our Ranges



Pistol Bays

- Handgun
- Rimfire Rifle
- Shotgun (stationary targets only)
- No engaging metal with shotgun slugs
- All shots must hit the berm
- Shooter must be a minimum of 10 yards away from metal targets
- Pick up your brass (exception rimfire)
- Return range to a clean state after usage
- If two or more persons on site, one must act as Range Officer
- Any exceptions to above must be authorized by an Executive Member

Rifle Bays

- All Firearms
- All shots must hit the berm
- No engaging metal targets with steel core ammo
- Shooter must be a minimum of 10 Meters away from metal targets
- Pick up your brass/hulls (exception rimfire)
- Return range to a clean state after usage
- If two or more persons on site, one must act as Range Officer
- Any exceptions to above must be authorized by an Executive Member

TARGETS & STANDS

- There are target stands to be used on the upper side of the seacan facing the shelter
- Please bring your own targets

Misc. Points

- Orientation Manual will be sent by email after CFO informed, plus any relevant newsletters etc.
- Check Facebook and calendar before heading out, in case of no access or events.
- Ensure awareness that ALL garbage must be removed, including ALL brass that is not .22: targets, backing, shotgun shells & wadding, personal props. Reloadable brass can be left in shelter.
- Advise that wood stove etc can be used, but supplies should be replaced.
- Advise member that no alcohol is permitted before or during range use.
- Review unauthorized targets i.e. barrels, pistol plate with rifles, pinning targets on target post stands, exploding targets, hard plastics/glass (that leave shards), anything blue etc and that all targets must be placed on target stands (explain correct placing of stand in base). Personal props and debris must be removed and taken home.
- No shooting steel with steel core ammunition.
- Respect the range, no open flames. Road is not plowed. Members can do maintenance if safe to do so, otherwise let us know what needs to be done.
- Don't just pay dues and expect others to do all the work. No paid staff and no caretakers.

- Breakfast, borrowing reloading equipment, club stores & orders.
