Feb. 7, 2019: What's Cooking at Century Bakery?



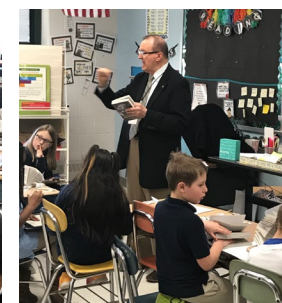

Jan. 31, 2019: Fellowship Day

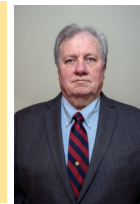
