### JANUARY 21: ROTARY CLUB MEETING INCLUDES DISCUSSION OF OPTIONS FOR CELEBRATING CLUB'S 100<sup>TH</sup> YEAR



The Bridgeton Rotary Club met via Zoom and phone on January 21. The program included discussion of more options for the celebration of the Club's 100<sup>th</sup> year. Tony Stanzione outlined two ideas he sent to the board for consideration. One was a traditional indoor dinner and celebration in the fall of 2021 or even in Feb. 2022, which would be the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the original charter celebration for the Club. The other idea was a visible project of some

kind, in addition to the BHS courtyard project. Tony used the beautification of the train trestle over Rt. 77 entering and leaving Bridgeton and installation and maintenance of an electronic community bulletin board somewhere in the area. Others suggested a mural depicting the history of the Club.

Romaine Street reviewed other ideas under consideration, including a timeline, a history of Club Presidents, and a picnic. The calendar raffle idea was dropped after concerns were raised about the number of tickets that would be needed to be sold and concerns about raffles in general based on moral and religious concerns.
