He said Carolyn Heckman's preliminary financial report indicated as much as a \$13,000 net profit was raised to support the community via the Club's charitable donations and its support of community projects. 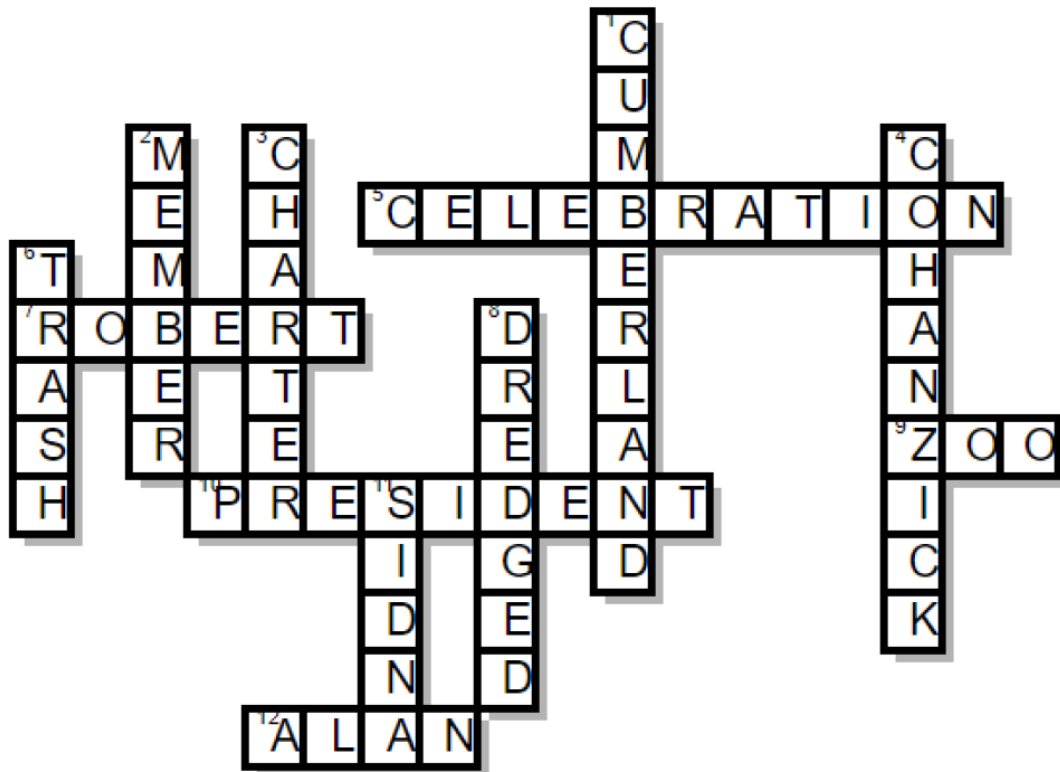
