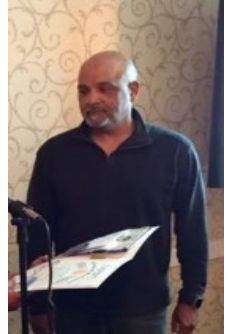

August 8, 2019: The Power of Girl Scouting in South Jersey

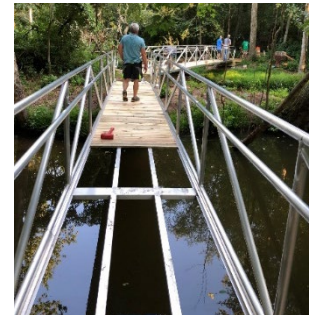
