BRIDGETON ROTARY CLUB HEADING TOWARD 100 YEARS OF SERVICE



The Bridgeton Rotary Club traces its roots to 1921 when it began meeting and received its Charter from Rotary International. The Rotary International Charter was approved Sept. 1, 1921. The charter presentation was celebrated on January 28, 1922 at the Bridgeton Armory with club members from Vineland, Camden, Atlantic City and others. Bridgeton Attorney Joseph W. Powell was elected the first president of Bridgeton Rotary Club. The Charter members and the Club had been active in promoting the building of the Cumberland Hotel which opened in 1922 and the club met there for many decades.
