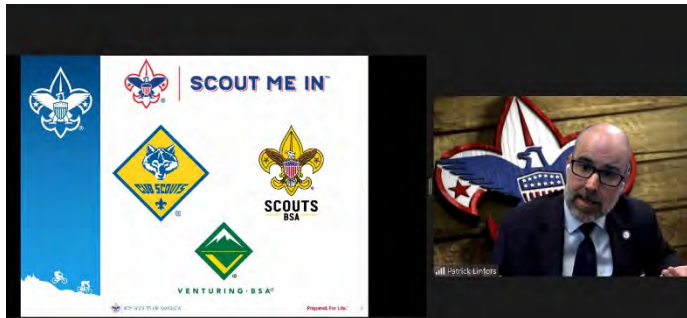

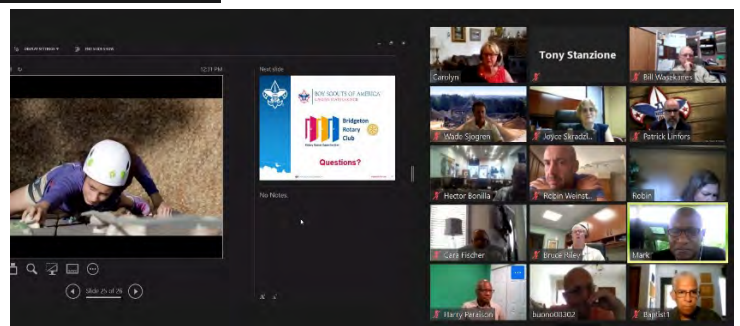
## AUG. 27: Boy Scouts of America, South Jersey Chapter Leader Patrick Linford
