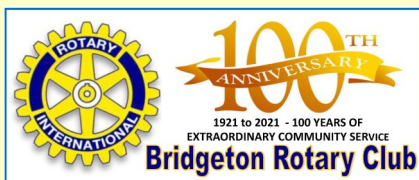

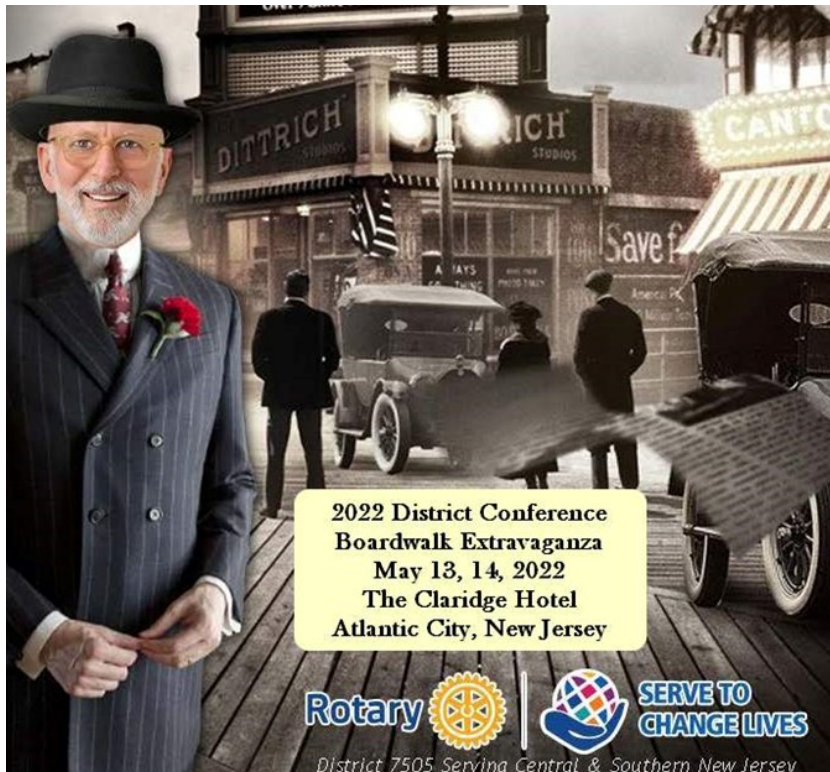
The new date and other information will be announced as soon as possible in the new year.
