downtown sidewalk, landscaping, and lighting improvements now underway on Laurel Street. He mentioned the nearly completed CompleteCare Health Network office building visible from Pearl Street and Laurel Street in downtown Bridgeton. It is the first major new building constructed downtown in several years. Mayor Kelly said the city welcomes the multi-million dollar expansion of Cumberland Dairy, construction on a large new cold storage facility by KMT Brr on Rosenhayn Avenue, new businesses in the Food Commercialization Center, and the construction of Wawa on Broad Street behind the former city hall. He also said that a new fire hall will be built in that area.
