

# Speaker Christina Riley Spoke About Her Work in Africa & Southeast Asia to Improve Health





On Sept. 2, the Bridgeton Rotary Club meeting at the Green Olive Restaurant and via Zoom featured a presentation by Christina Riley, daughter of Rotarian Bruce Riley, who is a Portfolio Lead at Akros, a small digital health NGO (non-governmental organization) that works across Africa and southeast Asia to establish data-driven systems to improve the health and well-being of disadvantaged communities. She

talked about the role her organization play in management, research, and technical implementation of programs that deploy a digital, geospatial platform called Reveal. Her talk included improving implementation of health programs, making them more effective, equitable, efficient, scalable, and sustainable for the populations they serve.
