**Hosting & Sponsoring Trainings**  
***Exploring the Sexual Offender & Violent Offender (domestic abuser)***

**Hosting**

- There is no cost to your agency.
- Providing a room for the training that would hold a minimum of 25 classroom style, with a projector for PowerPoint
- In return five of your officers attending the training for free
- Your agency would assist with distribution of the training flyer.
- I would advertise to other state and local law enforcement agencies, including U.S. Probation, probation, CPS/DHS, and prosecutors.
- I would provide a PDF training manual via email to each registrant.
- Participants register and pay for the training through my website.

**Sponsoring**

- With sponsoring, your agency is in charge. You may invite as many agencies and individuals as you wish to attend and arrange to split the fees accordingly. Any profit made belongs to your agency.
- Your agency would pay a fee of \$6,500.00, which includes all training and travel expenses. Half of the fee (approximately \$3,000.00) is due when securing the training dates. Payment of remainder of balance is due by the final day of training. Again, you have as many people attend as you want.
- A copy of the training manual would be provided for you to make a copy for each participant.

Sponsoring has worked out for many agencies in several States. Inviting local and federal probation, law enforcement agencies across the state, the county attorney's office and prosecutors, as well as mental health professionals, assures that all costs are covered, with the average cost per person averaging approximately \$162.00 or less for at least 40 people. An average training course will have 30-50 people attend and I have had several training courses exceed 100 participants. You can share the cost with other agencies.

He has over 35 years-experience addressing sexual predators as a forensic psychologist, author, educator, and police trainer.
