GRAVESITE DECORATION RULES (Updated 7/8/26)

Please help us keep this cemetery beautiful in honor of the loved ones interred here.

- 1 Decorations including fresh flowers, artificial flowers and non-breakable items are allowed in the in-ground vases, above ground vases and two non-breakable pots not to exceed 12" x 12"x 12". All flowers and decorations must be inside the vases or non-breakable containers and shall not impede upon the neighboring gravesite. Overall height of decorations must not exceed 24". Any items blown out or dislodged from their vases will be discarded. **To give families time to pick up decorations off the upright bases, we will be cleaning up these items on the base at the beginning of the year. January 19, 2027. All other rules are effective immediately.
- 2 Items that will be removed immediately: breakable materials including glass, ceramic, candles, statues, mylar balloons, headstone saddles, stuffed animals, food and beverages, rocks, cement, tubs, dish gardens, buckets, garland, adhesives, wax and items pressed into the grass.
- 3 Decorations for niches are only permitted on ground level. Nothing should be placed on top or affixed to the niche wall.
- 4 The Lemoore Cemetery District has the authority to remove all decorations or flowers (fresh or artificial) when deemed necessary. (Wilted, faded, torn, cluttered or unsightly)
- 5 Only Lemoore Cemetery District personnel shall plant, remove, or trim any trees, shrubs, flowers or grass within the Cemetery. Trimming around the monument by the public is not allowed.
- 6 Decorations that are directly related to Holidays recognized by the district will be allowed two weeks before the holiday and will be picked up one week after. These items must be inside the in-ground vase or non-breakable container. Floral decorations for Christmas will be allowed on December 1st and will be picked up on the third Monday of January.
- 7 The Trustees reserve the right to change or amend these rules at any time.

LEMOORE CEMETERY DISTRICT RULES

To ensure respect for all, the following is prohibited on cemetery grounds. PICNICS, BBQ, FOOD, DRINKS, ALCOHOL, DRUGS, LOUD MUSIC, CANOPY/POP-UP TENTS. This is not a recreational park. No playing on the monuments and parents are responsible for supervising their children. Lemoore Cemetery District is not liable for injury.

- 1 The Lemoore Cemetery District allows for one (1) monument per grave.
- 2 Monument setting fees must be paid before delivery and setting.
- 3 Monuments are the property of the purchaser. The Lemoore Cemetery District is not responsible for any damage or vandalism. Repairs will be at the owner's expense.
- 4 Lemoore Cemetery District is not liable for floral arrangements during funeral services. Every reasonable effort will be made to care for flowers and arrangements placed on graves.
- 5 Temporary monument markers such as planter boxes, dish gardens, engraved plates etc. are not allowed.
- 6 No domestic animals are allowed on the cemetery grounds except for service dogs.
- 7 Permanent vases for flowers must be set in concrete with the monument. Vases must be set by Cemetery personnel.
- 8 Because the Flag of the United States must be treated with respect and care, it is not allowed except at Memorial Day, Veteran's Day, Flag Day and the 4th of July. Otherwise, flags are to be displayed within a pot with floral decorations.
- 9 Maximum height allowed for all High Stone monuments is 4 feet 3 inches. (Base and Stone)
