innovation: Africa's (iA) local managers work with the village communities identified and funded by Water 4 Mercy, Inc. A 'Solar Water Committee' is created to conduct extensive training during the construction phase. After surveying the land, iA installs a solar powered deep water well accessing water that is trapped in the aquifers below the ground.



Addressing Village Wide Concerns



'Solar Water Committee' Involvement

A pump is inserted into the shaft with a solar panel connection to reach the aquifer, up to 400 Meters deep. This water is then deposited into a water tower that local villagers help construct. When water is needed, it is propelled by gravity to destinations around the village via 10 to 15 installed taps.

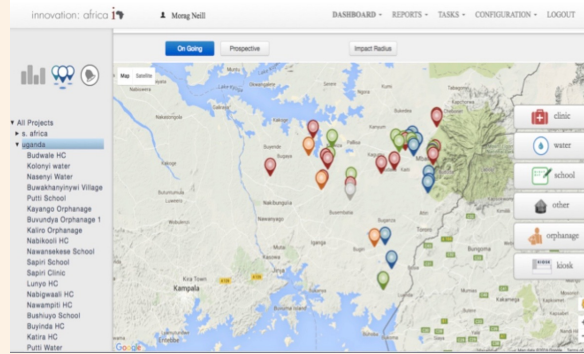
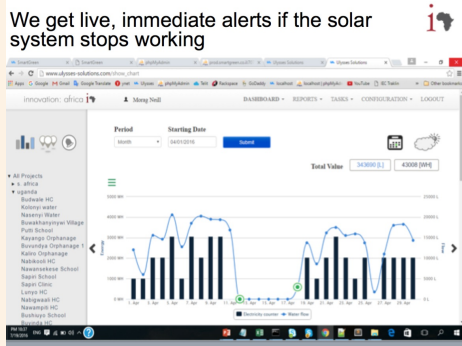

Installation of UN Award Winning Remote Monitoring System

iA's **UN Award Winning Remote Monitoring Technology** is installed. The custom designed system collects data from iA's solar powered pumps and sends that information to an online server that can be accessed from any computer or mobile **from anywhere in the world**. Smart technology is used to update key information.

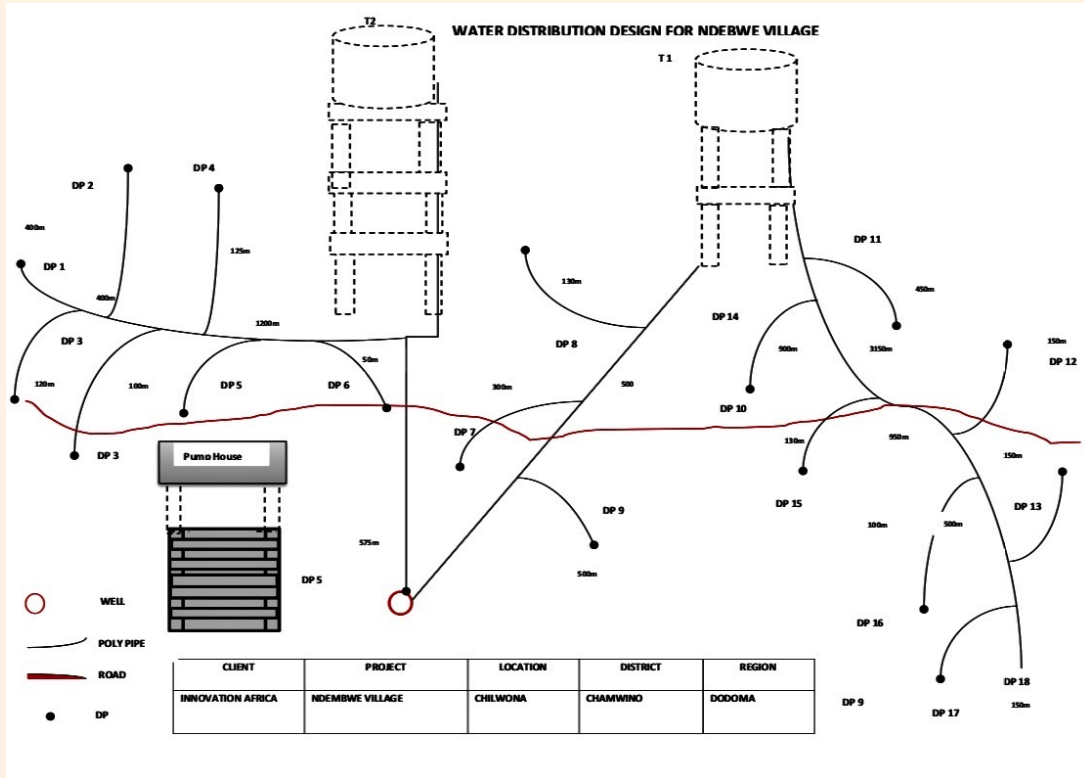
iA knows how much energy will be produced and consumed and **can predict problems before they start**. Moreover, by remote monitoring, the installed system is resistant to breakdown, vandalism, or theft and is **100% successful**.
