

Russian bombers capable of carrying nukes detected near Finland

The bombers, capable of carrying cruise missiles and strategic nuclear weapons, have been active in the Ukrainian war since Moscow invaded in February.

Israeli intelligence firm ImageSat International (ISI) has detected an “irregular presence” of Russian TU-160 and TU-95 strategic bombers deployed to the Olenya Airbase near Finland.

According to satellite images taken by the firm, four TU-160s were detected on August 21st and three TU-95s were detected on September 25th. There were no strategic bombers present at the airbase on August 12th.

“Through ongoing Patterns-of-Life, the system indicates that Engels air base is the possible departure point of the strategic bombers detected in Olenya airbase,” the report read.

Engels air base is home to Russia’s only strategic bombers stationed near Ukraine and is the home base for the 121st Heavy Bomber Aviation Regiment (121 TBAP) that flies the TU-160s and TU-95.

The bombers, capable of carrying cruise missiles and strategic nuclear weapons, have been active in the Ukrainian war since Moscow invaded in February. Throughout the war against Ukraine, the Russian Air Force has been [unable to gain air superiority](#) and has lost numerous aircraft.

According to The Drive, the regiment was awarded the honorific title of ‘Guards’- a prestigious title for Russian military units- for “mass heroism shown by the regiment’s personnel in [combat operations](#).”

While it is unclear why the bombers have been moved to the airbase, it comes as Russian President Vladimir Putin continues to threaten the West that he could use strategic nuclear weapons,

including after he announced a partial mobilization in the country, saying that “this is not a bluff.”

Olenya airbase is located on the Kola Peninsula near Murmansk. It houses Russia’s Northern Fleet and a significant number of arms and military hardware, including tactical and strategic nuclear weapons.

According to 2020 data released under the New START arms reduction treaty between Moscow and Washington, Russia has declared 1,447 deployed strategic warheads and has the capacity to deploy “many more than 1,550 warheads on its modernized ICBMs and SLBMs, as well as heavy bombers, but is constrained from doing so by New START.

The airbase is also a major Russian airbase which an enormous strike capacity that would [send a signal to the United States and NATO](#). The base is also out of range of Ukrainian weaponry which have been striking Russian airbases with weaponry delivered by Washington and other European nations.

Ukraine’s military intelligence spokesperson Vadym Skibitsky said in an interview with The Guardian on Tuesday that Kyiv assesses the threat of Moscow using tactical weapons against the country as “very high.”

According to Skibitsky, the tactical strikes would likely target locations along the front lines where there is a high number of people, equipment, as well as command centers, and critical infrastructure.

The speech of the President of Russia, B. Putin, brings dramatic global developments. Three points in his speech herald the use of nuclear weapons.

B. Putin emphasized that:

- the **United States created "doom"** by using nuclear weapons against Japan at the end of World War II;
- **warned that it will use all means to protect the four new areas, i.e. activation of strategic nuclear weapons**
- **and revealed that the Anglo-Saxons blew up the Nord Stream pipelines confirming WarNews247's revelations in the previous article. This is a "terrorist act against Russian assets"**

This means that the **military leadership has received the "green light" from B. Putin for the use of nuclear weapons in Ukraine.**

Declaration of B. Putin: They are our citizens and I will protect them by all means!

"I want the Kiev authorities and their real bosses in the West to listen to me: people in Donetsk, Luhansk, Kherson and Zaporizhia become our citizens. Forever!" said the Russian president.

"Russia will never betray the people of the four regions," Putin continued.

"We will defend our land with all the forces and means at our disposal, we will do everything to ensure the safe life of our people. This is the great liberating mission of our people," added the Russian president.

"The people made their choice in the referendums on the territories of Ukraine," Putin said at the Kremlin's fiesta for the annexation of new Ukrainian territories.

"This is the will of millions of people. That is their right. Their first right, enshrined in Article 1 of the United Nations Charter, is the right to decide for themselves about their own destiny," he added.

"We signed the annexation of 4 regions with Russia. This is a fundamental human right and a historical right. It is the right of citizens, the elderly and women who have suffered the terrorist attack of the Kiev regime. It is the choice of people from different ethnic backgrounds.

I applaud the commanders. All our soldiers who lost their lives in a special operation for the defense of our people in the region are true heroes," he noted.

"Citizens in the regions of Ukraine made their choices, we signed their annexation and we hope the parliament will accept it. Besides, the right to self-determination is provided for in the UN Charter.

This is where our great-grandfathers fought. All those who want to have the right to live are victims of the inhumane actions of the Kiev regime. We will build the infrastructure and increase security so that the citizens feel the full support of mother Russia.

We will never betray them, they will become Russian citizens. The 1991 decision was not based on the will of the citizens. Russia has no aspirations for the revival of the USSR. The truth is on our side."

At another point in his speech, Putin said that **"we are ready for talks with Ukraine. We call on the Kiev regime to immediately cease all hostilities, the war it launched in 2014 and return to the negotiating table.**

Kyiv must respect the choice of citizens in Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhia and Kherson. This is the only way to peace .

"We call on Kiev to immediately stop military actions and return to the negotiating table," he added.

"We are ready for talks with Ukraine. We have said this more than once," said the Russian president at Friday's party.

The Russian president repeated the narrative of reuniting Ukrainians with mother Russia, but emphasized that he did not wish to proceed with a reconstitution of the Soviet Union, in terms of its pre-1991 borders.

The Anglo-Saxons blew up the pipelines

At the same time, he openly accused the USA and Britain (Anglo-Saxons) of sabotaging the Nord Stream pipelines, as "only they would benefit from such an act".

"Sanctions were not enough for the Anglo-Saxons: they proceeded with sabotage," said B. Putin.

"It's hard to believe, but it's a fact that they organized the explosions on the Nord Stream international gas pipeline," the Russian president said.

"By staging explosions in the international Nord Stream natural gas pipelines that run along the bottom of the Baltic Sea, they actually began to destroy the pan-European energy infrastructure," the president added.

"The West is looking for a new opportunity to weaken and destroy Russia. But there is such a great country and they don't count that.

The West wants to make Russia a colony, but we will protect our rights.

The Russophobia of the West is racist. It is important for the West that countries surrender their sovereignty for the sake of the US."

"Their promises not to expand NATO were a lie. They are waging a hybrid war against us, they want to destroy our civilization. The US dominates Germany, Korea and Japan, yet they talk about equal rights.

They want to do the same with Russia, China and Iran.

It is the US that is destroying European energy infrastructure. The USA believed that with the sanctions against Russia, they would be able to fix the world .

The US is leading Europe away from Russian energy sources and, consequently, into its deindustrialization. Those who want to live by US rules are masochists."

"The West has no moral right to talk about democracy," he said, adding that **"there are reasons to believe that Western countries are not looking for a way out of the global food crisis."**

"The West is looking for new opportunities to hit us and has always dreamed of breaking up our state into smaller states that will fight each other," Vladimir Putin said, accusing the US of two standards.

The USA's predestination with nuclear weapons

He also declared that the United States created "doom" by using nuclear weapons against Japan at the end of World War II, in a speech full of hostility toward the West.

"They are accusing us of going nuclear when they have done it twice themselves."

"The United States is the only country in the world to have used nuclear weapons twice, destroying the Japanese cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. By the way, they set a precedent," he said, also recalling that the U.S., along with the British, *"turned Dresden, Hamburg, Cologne and many other German cities into ruins during World War II."*

The culture gap with the West: Parent A and parent B

He then referred to a **"cultural" gap** between Russia and the West, which he accused of Satanism, while addressing the Russian people he asked them to imagine if instead of father and mother they would call him parent A and parent B, while he asked his audience if he really wants his children to **"offer for sex reassignment operations."**

"We are witnessing pure satanism in the West. Do we want our children to be offered sex reassignment operations?"

It is unacceptable!

Our future is different. We are fighting for a great, historic Russia," stressed B. Putin.

He submitted the union plan to the Duma

Earlier, Vladimir Putin notified the State Duma of the applications and plan of the Luhansk, Donetsk, Zaporizhia and Kherson regions to join the Russian Federation, State Duma Chairman Vyacheslav Volodin said.

"The president of the Russian Federation notified the State Duma of the requests of the Donetsk People's Republic, the Luhansk People's Republic, the Zaporizhia region and the Kherson region to accept them into the Russian Federation as new subjects," Volodin reported on her channel.

Global Alert - Russia: "We Have Evidence - Westerners Blow Up Nord Stream" - Retaliating with Strike on GTS Pipeline & Undersea Cables

What scenarios is Moscow considering - And how Turkey can benefit

Rapid escalation in the West-Russia energy war is brought by Moscow's declaration that it has evidence of Western involvement in the blowing up of the Nord Stream pipelines.

It is the first time that Moscow explicitly mentions that the West blew up the pipelines and even has evidence of this "terrorist action" against "Russian assets".

A while ago, Sergei Naryskin, the head of Russia's foreign intelligence service SVR, said that Moscow has evidence showing that the West is responsible for the leaks in the Nord Stream undersea pipelines.

"We have materials that show a Western trace in the organization and implementation of these terrorist acts," he said specifically.

"In my opinion, the West is doing everything to hide the real perpetrators and organizers of this international act of terrorism," he added.

The fact that the head of the SVR made statements means only one thing: Escalation and retaliation.

Naryskin's statement is the most direct accusation against the West by a senior Russian official on the case. He did not reveal what evidence Russia has.

President Vladimir Putin said yesterday, Thursday, that the "unprecedented sabotage" against the Nord Stream pipelines was "an act of international terrorism".

At the same time, a prosecution for an act of international terrorism has been brought by the Russian General Prosecutor's Office and the investigation has been assigned to the Federal Security Service.

Moscow is now setting the stage, whether what it says is true or not, for retaliation against Europe and the US.

Also, the **fact that power transmission lines were hit shows that the first taboo was "broken". Until now, it was considered unthinkable for another country's energy pipelines to hit the country.** And certainly this action is considered a prelude to a nuclear strike. This is the second taboo that is going to be "broken".

Global alert – Russian retaliation expected

There are two possible versions of retaliation from Moscow: Hitting a pipeline that supplies the EU or destroying submarine internet cables.

However, we remind you **that recently the Russian Fleet exercised within the Exclusive Economic Zone of Ireland in scenarios of imposing a "blackout" on the telecommunications connection between Europe and the USA.**

According to maps that have seen the light of day, underwater telecommunications cables pass through the site of the Russian exercise. **If these are cut, then a large part of Europe will be isolated as communication with the US will be cut off.**

The location of the Russian exercise was right in the area through which many transatlantic internet cables run connecting Europe and North America.

Increased military measures in Norway, Finland, Baltic, Italy and other countries

An unidentified drone flew near a TotalEnergies oil and gas facility in the North Sea on Wednesday.

"We observed unauthorized drone activity at the Halfdan B oil and gas field in the North Sea," a company spokesman said in a written comment, adding that the activity had been observed on Wednesday.

"We have taken the necessary measures in accordance with our security procedures and are in close dialogue with the authorities," he added.

It is **noted that the countries of the North and Baltic seas are taking one after the other increasingly strict measures to guard their energy facilities,** after the incalculable damage to the Nord Stream 1 and 2 pipelines which are probably due to sabotage.

Finland, Russia's neighbor, today ordered increased security at the country's strategically important infrastructure, while Lithuania is also taking additional measures to boost security at its liquefied natural gas (LNG) import terminal.

In Sweden, the country's two main nuclear power plants located in Forsmark (central east) and Ringals (southwest) announced they were put on "heightened alert" due to the events in the Baltic Sea.

Similar measures have been taken by Germany, Denmark and Norway, which is now the leading natural gas exporter in Europe.

The **Norwegian government is stepping up "readiness" and "control" on the Norway-Russia border as the Norwegian parliament's expanded foreign affairs and defense committee convenes for a "secret crisis meeting"** this morning, where they will be briefed by the government on the ongoing security status.

Military forces will be deployed near Norway's oil and gas facilities following suspected sabotage of the Nord Stream gas pipelines in Danish and Swedish territorial waters.

The military **"will be more visible at Norwegian facilities"** extracting oil and natural gas, Prime Minister Gar Stere said at a news conference.

Stere also said that **oil companies will also strengthen their security at their offshore facilities.**

At the same time, the Italian Navy will increase the protection of natural gas pipelines

First scenario: The GTS pipeline is permanently closed

A terrorist attack in the Baltic Sea will have far-reaching consequences. On September 27, 2022, the day voting for the referendums ended, the lines of the Nord Stream and Nord Stream 2 undersea gas pipelines were blown up. This sabotage can completely change the future alignment of

the "Ukrainian affair".

Indeed, the one-time shutdown of the pipeline infrastructure, which allows a total of up to 110 billion cubic meters of Russian gas to be pumped annually to Europe, is a serious blow to Europe.

If the Ukrainian GTS is also disabled, the cost to Europe will be terrifying.

In the near future, if Russian pipelines to the south are also sabotaged, we will see who really wants to preserve exports to Europe more: the EU on the eve of the start of the heating season or Gazprom itself.

If the Kremlin wants a decisive victory over the "Western partners", then the situation with the "Nord Streams" will be used in Russia's favor, and gas supplies through the Ukrainian GTS will be reduced even more and then completely stopped until the military support of Kiev.

There is already a dispute between the Russian giant Gazprom and the Ukrainian operator Naftogaz.

Naftogaz has appealed to an arbitration court, accusing Gazprom of not paying it on time or in full for transiting gas through Ukraine.

For its part, Gazprom has argued that it is being hampered by Western sanctions against Russia, threatening to end the flow of Russian gas through Ukraine.

Specifically, Gazprom said that Russia may impose sanctions against Naftogaz if it continues with the arbitration case, which would mean that Gazprom would be prohibited from paying Ukraine transit fees.

If the flows stop, then Western Europe will be completely cut off, leaving only TurkStream to send gas to Turkey and southeastern Europe.

This scenario is very likely as Russia will gain absolute control through Turkey, upgrading the position of Ankara.

Second scenario: Attack on submarine cables

The **attacks on the two Nord Stream natural gas pipelines have raised concerns that the undersea cables connecting humanity to the internet are at risk. Western policymakers are asking: what will be the goal next?**

No one has yet claimed responsibility for the attacks on the Nord Stream energy pipelines. But US and European officials were quick to point the finger at the Kremlin – **amid warnings that the labyrinthine network of undersea cables that feed the global internet could be a tempting target.**

The threat is real. In part, this is due to insufficient security around these cables.

"It's been a target in conflicts for more than a decade now," Keir Giles, an expert on Russian intelligence warfare at Chatham House, a think tank, told Politico.

"If special attention is not paid to securing these vital assets, Western countries will have only themselves to blame afterwards."

Almost all of the world's Internet traffic is carried over a global network of more than 400 fiber optic pipelines spanning a total of 1.3 million kilometers. They are operated almost exclusively by private companies such as Google and Microsoft, as well as France's Alcatel Submarine Networks and, increasingly, China's Huawei Marine Networks.

There are dozens of these cables connecting the EU to the United States – arguably the world's most important "digital link" – although similar networks connect Latin America to Asia and Africa to Europe, respectively.

Part of the vulnerability is due to the location of these cables. They span the globe and are often located in extremely remote areas that are easily accessible by underwater or unmanned underwater vehicles. **Most of these pipelines are located in international waters.**

There are also the **areas where major submarine cables intersect, which represent some of the highest risk potential targets. For Europe, these include Gibraltar and Malta,** where many of the EU's connections to Asia reach land after passing through Egypt's Suez Canal.

For the US, New York's coastline is the main point of connection with Europe. The west coast of the United Kingdom represents a connecting hub between the US and the rest of Europe.

If the Kremlin did attack, for example, it could potentially bring down part of a regional network connecting the Baltic states to the rest of Europe.

But to have a long-term impact on the global undersea cable network, Russia – or any other aggressor – would

have to act on a scale that would likely be easily detectable by Western national security agencies.

N.Korea fires ballistic missiles, marking fourth in a week

North Korea fired two short-range ballistic missiles towards the sea off the east coast on Saturday, South Korea's military said, marking Pyongyang's fourth launch in a week as it ratchets up tension around the Korean peninsula.

The launch comes after the navies of South Korea, the United States and Japan staged trilateral anti-submarine exercises on Friday for the first time in five years and follows US Vice President Kamala Harris' visit to the region this week.

The two short-range missiles were launched from Sunan, north of the North Korean capital Pyongyang, South Korea's Joint Chiefs of Staff said in a statement. It estimated the range at 350 kilometers (217.5 miles) at 30 km altitude and a speed of Mach 6.

Japan's coast guard also reported at least two suspected ballistic missile tests by Pyongyang. The missiles flew 400 km and 350 km, reaching an altitude of 50 km, Japan's State Minister of Defence Toshiro Ino said.

Tokyo has lodged a protest against the North through diplomatic channels, Ino said, adding the missiles possibly flew an "irregular trajectory" designed to evade missile defense.

Are the missile launches a threat in any way?

The US Indo-Pacific Command said it is aware of the ballistic missile launches and has assessed they do not pose an immediate threat to US personnel or territory or to its allies.

North Korea fired missiles before and after Harris' visit to [South Korea](#), extending a record pace in weapons testing this year as it increases the threat of a credible nuclear power that can strike the United States and its allies.

Pyongyang also conducted the first intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM) test since 2017.

Analysts see the increased pace of testing as an effort to build operational weapons, as well as to take advantage of a world distracted by the Ukraine conflict and other crises to "normalize" its tests.

"Despite North Korea's internal weaknesses and international isolation, it is rapidly modernizing weapons and taking advantage of a world divided by US-China rivalry and Russia's annexation of more Ukrainian territory," Professor Leif-Eric Easley at Ewha University in Seoul said.

"The Kim regime is also playing hardball with the Yoon administration while South Korean politics are hobbled by infighting," referring to the South Korean president. **MORE -** <https://www.jpost.com/breaking-news/article-718639>

Iran ordered security forces to 'severely confront' protesters — rights group

Leaked documents obtained by Amnesty include demands for harsh action against anti-government demonstrators, also reveal beatings and sexual assaults of women who removed hijabs

DUBAI, United Arab Emirates — Leaked government documents show that Iran ordered its security forces to "severely confront" antigovernment demonstrations that broke out earlier this month, Amnesty International said Friday.

The London-based rights group said security forces have killed at least 52 people since protests over the death of a woman detained by the morality police began nearly two weeks ago, including by firing live ammunition into crowds and beating protesters with batons.

It says security forces have also beaten and groped female protesters who remove their headscarves to protest the treatment of women by Iran's theocracy.

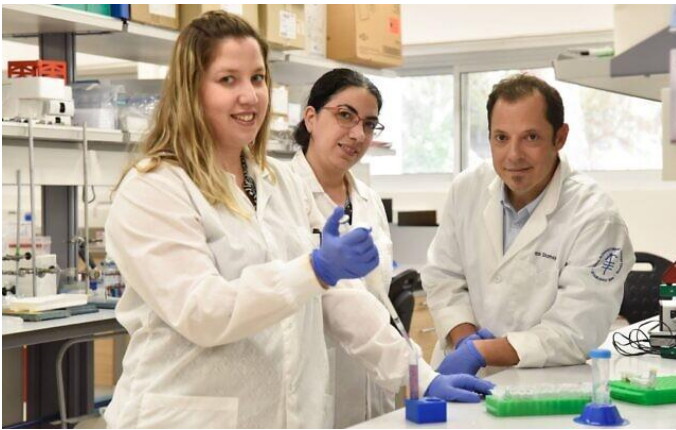
The death in custody of Mahsa Amini, who was detained for allegedly wearing the mandatory Islamic headscarf too loosely, has triggered an outpouring of anger at Iran's ruling clerics.

Her family says they were told she was beaten to death in custody. Israeli nanotech may be able to reduce side-effects of chemotherapy, scientists say

Precision dosing invention gets drugs just to affected cells and not whole body; already tested on mice with inhibitor drugs; inventors also aiming at chemo and other treatments

Scientists say that new Israeli technology could dramatically reduce the side effects of cancer treatments, including chemotherapy, by making precision dosing possible for drugs that are currently administered to the whole body.

The invention could also revive numerous treatments that are today considered unsafe and enable doctors to increase doses of some existing medicines, the team from the Technion-Israel Institute of Technology suggests in [newly peer-](#)

[reviewed research.](#)

The main focus of the study – and the sole topic of the Technion team's animal study – is inhibitors, which are drugs that block the growth factors that trigger cancer cells. But a small number of chemotherapies was included in the lab testing and showed promise, the team said, indicating that the technology may also one day be used to reduce chemotherapy side effects.

Precision medicines are considered a promising way to treat cancer, but a major challenge is the technology required to deliver medicine to cancerous cells without taking it to other parts of the body.

Particles called nano-carriers — also a key ingredient of most coronavirus vaccines — do the job well. But each nano-carrier is compatible with a limited range of drugs, and only a few dozen are available, meaning the vast majority of drugs can't be given as precision medicine. **MORE -** <https://www.timesofisrael.com/israeli-tech-can-reduce-side-effects-and-increase-range-of-cancer-drugs-scientists/>

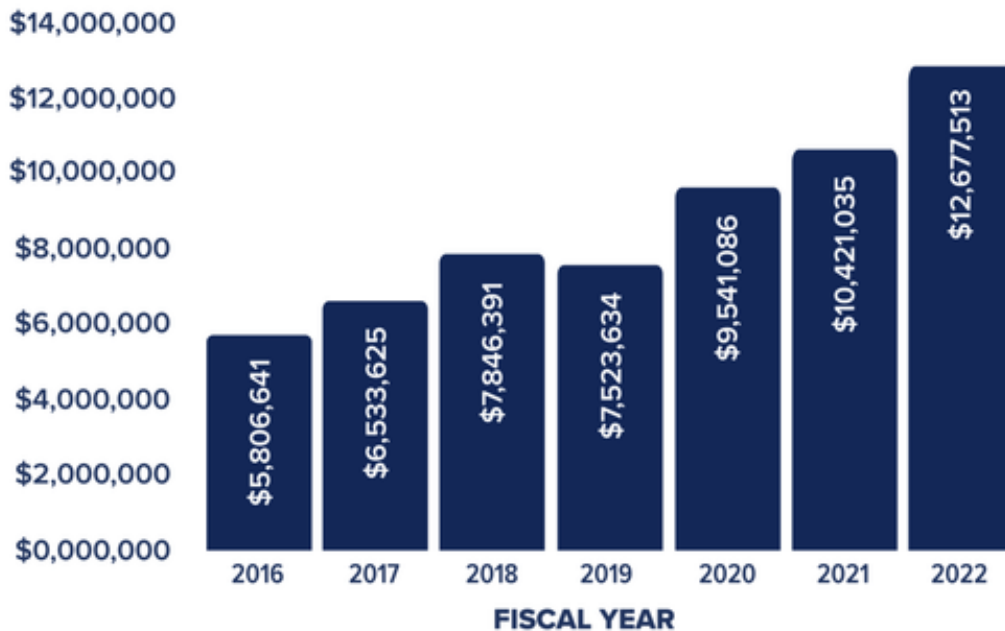
Fauci Net Worth Soared 66% During Pandemic

The net worth of Dr. Anthony Fauci's household soared a whopping 66% over the course of the pandemic, according to new financial disclosures obtained by OpenTheBooks.com. Fauci reported a Jan 1, 2019 net worth of \$7,523,634. By Jan 1, 2022, it had grown to \$12,677,513.

As director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, Fauci was paid a 2021 salary of \$456,028, making him the highest-paid employee in the entire federal government. His wife, Christine Grady, is chief bio-ethicist for the National Institutes of Health, does very well too, raking in a \$238,970 salary last year.

Fauci is famously paid more than the president, and his wife collects more than the vice president. However, those hefty federal salaries aren't the only driver of the Fauci household's pandemic-era enrichment.

In 2021, Fauci was awarded the [Tel Aviv University](#)-affiliated [Dan David Prize](#), which came with a \$1 million check. The prize committee said Fauci "has been widely praised for his courage in [speaking truth to power](#)" during the Covid-19 pandemic.

The committee was apparently oblivious that Fauci was the power and routinely spoke falsehoods about everything from the [usefulness of masking](#) to [herd immunity](#), the [efficacy of vaccines](#), and NIH funding of [gain of function research](#) at the Wuhan Institute.

As is customary, Fauci donated some of his prize money back to be awarded as student scholarships, but still pocketed \$901,400, according to the financial statements reviewed by OpenTheBooks.com.

Though it's chump change compared to the Dan David Prize, Fauci also scored \$12,500 from both the Elliot Richardson Prize in Public Service and the Abelson Prize from the American Association for the Advancement of Science, and got \$5,198 when he was named Federal Employee of the Year at the 2020 [Samuel J. Heyman](#) Service to America Medals ceremony.

Fauci even did some moonlighting as an editor for McGraw Hill, taking home \$100,000 for his work in 2021.
