The Russians captured Spirne, Andreevka, Ozaryanovka, Zelenopolye: They broke through the Ukrainian defenses at Bakhmut and are advancing towards Chasiv Yar!

The Ukrainians are in a very difficult position - They are leaving the southern suburbs

The Russian Armed Forces are making their biggest advance in months in the Donbass, registering significant territorial gains and laying the foundations for a major Ukrainian defeat in the Donbass.

Within 24 hours Russian and allied forces captured the town of Spirne/Spornoye and the settlements of Andreevka, Ozaryanovka, Zelenopolye while the settlement of Kurdyumivka also fell. Ukrainian forces withdraw from the southern suburbs of Bakhmut as a result of the Russian advance.

As WarNews247 had noted, the entire southern Ukrainian defensive line (maps at the end of the text) collapsed. The Russians are preparing for the finishing blow by advancing towards Chasiv Yar rather than the city of Bakhmut itself with the aim of a complete operational encirclement.

In the town of Spirne/Spornoye, Russian clearance operations are underway in the outskirts after the withdrawal of the Ukrainian Army from the town center.

Spirne is between Artyomovsk and Lisichansk: The area has been literally leveled with corpses of Ukrainian soldiers lying everywhere. The 4th Brigade of the 2nd Lugansk Army Corps is fighting in the area.

Russian troops occupied Andreevka - Why it is a "key" location!

Yesterday PMC Wagner forces captured the settlements of Ozaryanovka and Zelenopolye, located west of the highway leading to Artyomovsk from Donetsk and Gorlovka.

A while ago the "Musicians" also occupied the Andreevka area, a village located about 7 kilometers from the southern suburbs of Bakhmut (Artyomovsk).

The capture of the Ozaryanovka, Andreevka and Zelenopolye districts allows Russian and allied forces to develop new offensive energy covering Bakhmut from the south.

At the same time through the capture of the Andreevka area, the Russians can attempt a new advance to the north and northwest to reach the Kleshcheevka area and establish artillery control of the Konstantinovka-Artemovsk road.

This is the main supply route for Ukrainian forces in Bakhmut!

Along this road, the command of the Armed Forces of Ukraine is trying to send reinforcements to the city. At the same time, Ukrainians inside the city report that the shooting from automatic weapons in the southern suburbs of the city can now be heard very clearly. The Russians are getting dangerously close.

It is also important to note that by capturing these settlements, Russian troops are pushing Ukrainian forces away from Gorlovka in the northern direction.

Ukrainian defense line south of Artyomovsk breached – Chasiv Yar next target

This morning, the forces of PMC Wagner with the support of the 1st Guards Army, captured the settlements of Zelenopolje and Ozaryanovka in a few hours, a sample of the Ukrainian collapse.

The **Russians continue the further advance in this direction to the west of the Artemovsk-Mayorsk** highway.

Russian troops and Wagner PMC strike groups have reportedly expanded their zone of control near Artemovsk and are now fighting in the Kurdyumovka settlement.

According to the Russians, on a daily basis the Ukrainians have up to 240 dead and wounded. The reserves transferred by the Ukrainian administration do not make up for the current losses of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

In addition to personnel, the loss of military equipment is very large in the direction of Artemovsk. For the transportation of ammunition and offensive weapons, the Armed Forces of Ukraine now use medical transporters, which, in turn, complicates the evacuation of the wounded and leads to even greater losses.

Due to the inability to hold the southern suburbs of Bakhmut, a shift in the positions of the Armed Forces of Ukraine is recorded.

The Ukrainian military calls the current situation in Bakhmut critical. Tragic conditions for millions of Ukrainians

The Mayor of Kyiv, Vitali Klitschko, issued a recommendation to evacuate Kyiv, stressing that "anyone who has a house in the suburbs with water, heating or friends should go.

Those who can move now to the suburbs of Kiev, to their summer house or to their friends' residence, if there is water supply and they have a fireplace, move immediately," Klitschko emphasized.

In an interview with RBK-Ukraine, Kyiv mayor Vitali Klitschko stressed that residents of the Ukrainian capital should be prepared for "the worst case scenario".

The **most serious crisis is located in central and eastern Ukraine as Russian raids are more frequent in these areas.**

Earlier, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky estimated that 14 of Ukraine's 27 regions and Kyiv have been cut off, which equates to more than 100,000 consumers per region.

"This shows us how important it is to store energy and consume it within a reasonable framework," added the Ukrainian president.

It is noted that the New York Times had reported on November 6 that the authorities in Kiev had begun planning the evacuation of the city's three million residents in the event of a complete blackout in the Ukrainian capital. After the reactions, Roman Tkachuk, director of the security department of Kyiv, had denied the information.

On November 23, Russia launched its fifth massive attack on energy infrastructure on Ukrainian territory, causing widespread power, telecommunications and water outages in Kyiv and other cities. The previous heavy Russian attacks took place on 10 October, 17 October, 31 October and 15 November. According to Klitschko, the day after the November 23 attack, 70% of households in Kyiv were without power.

Recommendation of the Mayor of Kyiv: "Leave the city"!

Klitschko called on Kiev residents to prepare for a prolonged blackout in the capital by stocking up on food, water, warm clothes and power banks.

Regarding the speculation that there are plans to evacuate Kiev due to the Russian attacks, Klitschko specifically said that it would be a "big mistake" if they do not prepare for different scenarios by confirming this information.

Specifically stated:

"We have to be prepared for different scenarios, even the bad ones.

In this case, each of us has an algorithm of actions, even evacuation.

I am not ruling out the worst case scenario which is evacuation.

There will not be a complete evacuation, maybe a partial evacuation, but it is forbidden to call it an evacuation.

It will be a temporary relocation of certain categories of people to the suburbs, where the proper services will be available," argued Klitschko, who even called on those who are able to leave the city to do so.

"In the case of a bad scenario, it would be good for anyone who has a house in the suburbs with water, heating or friends, to go," emphasized the mayor of Kyiv.

He did not specify which areas these are, whether the authorities will organize the relocation or whether the citizens themselves will be relocated, which he himself had requested. He also asked those who can now move to the suburbs of Kiev, in their summer house or in the residence of their friends, if there is water supply and they have a fireplace.

No power until spring

He said **they should prepare for back-to-back power outages that could last until next spring.**

"We have to be prepared for the fact that power outages may continue into the spring.

This is due to the low temperatures, but also because many people have devices that provide heat, some have warm floors.

People always consume more electricity when the weather is cold, and that's why there is a big load on the energy system," emphasized Klitschko.

Political civil war in Ukraine - Mayor of Kyiv: "I don't want to get involved in political disputes"

At **the same time, Kyiv Mayor Vitali Klitschko warned of political unrest due to power outages and appealed for calm.**

"We must continue to work together to defend the country and protect the infrastructure," he noted, adding that authorities are looking for a solution in **"record time."**

"I don't want to get involved in political disputes, especially in the current situation," Klitschko said in a video posted on Telegram.

"This is meaningless. I have things to do in town."

Klitschko, who had clashed numerous times with Zelenskiy before the Russian invasion, said allies of the president had engaged in "misrepresentations" about the city's efforts, including "incomprehensible photos" posted online.

"To put it mildly, this is not nice. Neither for the Ukrainians nor for our foreign partners," Klitschko said. Today, as ***never before, everyone must unite and work together. And here we have some kind of political games."***

As Klitschko said, at the moment in Kyiv there are 430 points that provide heating and are working.

Asked about the criticism leveled at him regarding shortcomings and problems in the organization, he said that the issue is being politicized.

"When I meet MPs from the ruling party either on detours or at checkpoints, they tell me everything is working fine, and then I see them making posts saying everything is bad.

This is not good for the residents of the city or for our foreign allies," said Klitschko, who estimated that more than 3.3 million people currently live in Kyiv.

"We have about 3.35 million inhabitants, calculation based on the use of smartphones" emphasized the mayor of Kyiv.

Zelensky last week referred to **"invincible centers"** to be set up across Ukraine to provide free 24-hour electricity, heating, water, internet and a pharmacy

In his late-night video speech on Friday, Zelensky said the mayor of Kyiv had not done enough to help the capital's residents.

"To put it mildly, more work is needed," the Ukrainian president said.

Zelenskiy was elected overwhelmingly in 2019, five years after Klitschko first took office. Before the war, the two political leaders had clashed over the way the capital and its services were run.

Snow and bitter cold in Kyiv with Ukrainians without electricity and heating

Snow is falling in Kyiv and the temperature is hovering around zero as tens of thousands of residents of the

Ukrainian capital remain without electricity and heating.

The cold weather is gradually increasing consumers' energy needs and technicians are racing against time to repair energy infrastructure damaged by Russian bombing, grid operator Ukrenergo said.

Power producers are still unable to fully feed the grid after Russia's missile attacks last Wednesday and have no choice but to save power by forcing blackouts, he added.

"The consumption restriction regime remains in force due to the deficit, which is around 20%," Ukrenergo said in a Telegram post yesterday.

Moscow has targeted critical infrastructure in recent weeks, causing widespread blackouts. Last Wednesday's attacks caused the worst damage to date, leaving millions without electricity, water or heating as the mercury dropped below zero degrees Celsius.

David Arakhamiya, the head of President Volodymyr Zelensky's party, predicted that Russia would launch new attacks on infrastructure this week, which is expected to be "really difficult".

On Saturday night, November 26, Zelensky said there were restrictions on the use of electricity in 14 of Ukraine's 27 regions - including Kyiv and its surroundings. These restrictions affect more than 100,000 consumers in each region. "If consumption increases at night, the number of power outages may increase," he said in his daily address, repeating his appeal to citizens to save energy.

Forecasters predict that the snowfall in Kyiv will continue until the middle of the week, while the temperature will remain at very low levels.

Four hours of electricity a day

Sergey Kovalenko, head of the YASNO company that supplies electricity to Kyiv, said the situation in the city had improved but remained "quite difficult".

He explained that residents should have electricity for at least four hours a day. **"If you didn't have electricity for at least four hours yesterday, contact the Kyiv Electric Network DTEK, colleagues will help you find what the problem is,"** he wrote on his Facebook page.

YASNO is the retail arm of DTEK, the largest private energy company.

Ukrenergo warned that blackouts would continue and urged consumers to limit energy use.

"We want to remind you that now, every Ukrainian whose house has electricity restored, can help restore it for others faster, just by consuming electricity sparingly," the company said.

Kherson is a ghost town again: Hundreds of Ukrainians are leaving the city

Hundreds of Ukrainians fled the city of Kherson on Sunday. The evacuations began last week amid fears that damage to infrastructure was too severe for people to withstand Ukraine's harsh winter, where the snowfall began.

The mass exodus has now gotten bigger because of the Russian bombings.

"It's sad that we're leaving our home," Yevhen Yankov told The Associated Press.

"Now we are free, but we have to leave, because there are bombings and there are dead people in the population."

Galina Lugova, the head of the city's military administration, said authorities **"will do everything to keep people safe," but "the shelling is intensifying every day. Bombings, bombings and more bombings."**

Vitaliy Nadochiy told AP that the artillery hit his house. **"Four apartments were burnt. The windows were broken,"** he said. **"We can't be there. There is no electricity, water, heating. Nightmare admission from the German ZDF: "Ukraine will be plunged into total darkness in a short time"

"All critical infrastructure will stop working"

The colonel of the Austrian Ministry of Defense, Colonel Markus Reisner, said that Ukraine will be completely cut off from electricity in a few weeks if the West stops helping Kyiv!

"If a strong air defense system is not developed here, Ukraine will be plunged into total darkness in a few weeks," said Markus Reisner in an interview with ZDF.

The military noted that despite supplies from the West, **"due to the enormous size of the country and the large number of objects that require protection, it is almost impossible to do anything about it."**

"If large-scale air defense systems are not provided, then in a few weeks there will be complete darkness in Ukraine, because all critical infrastructure will stop working," he underlined.

According to the colonel, Kyiv was vulnerable to infrastructure attacks after the Russian Armed Forces destroyed a third of Ukraine's air defense systems.

The West also underestimated Moscow's capabilities, Reisner believes.

In the meantime, the dramatic situation in which Ukraine has fallen was confirmed by the mayor of Kyiv, Vitaly Klitschko, who, after asserting that it is very likely that the blackouts will continue until next spring, while he did not rule out the worst scenarios, such as the partial evacuation of Kiev.

Speaking to the RBC-Ukraine agency, Klitschko urged the city's residents to be ready for all scenarios.

"We have to be prepared for different scenarios, even the bad ones.

In this case, each of us has an algorithm of actions, even evacuation.

I am not ruling out the worst case scenario which is evacuation. There will not be a complete evacuation, maybe there will be a partial evacuation," he noted.

Russia: "More than 700 Ukrainian commandos are preparing to attack the Zaporizhia nuclear power plant"

Fierce battles are expected

More than 700 Ukrainian commandos are currently in the Kyiv-controlled part of the Zaporizhia region, Moscow-appointed regional commander Vladimir Rogov said.

"More than 700 soldiers from the Ukrainian special operations forces have been deployed in the Zaporizhia region. They have been trained to cross the Dnieper River, land an assault force and seize large industrial facilities and the nuclear power plant," the Russian official said.

However, he argued that Russia's strikes on Ukrainian ammunition depots **"disrupt these plans of the Ukrainian military."**

For their part, Ukrainian forces destroyed a railway bridge near the village of Starobohdanivka in the Zaporizhia region, which the Russians were using to deliver military equipment and weapons to Russian troops stationed in the rest of Ukraine's occupied territories, according to the Ukrainian National Security Service.

Yesterday, the adviser to the Ukrainian president, Volodymyr Zelensky, said that he has no doubt that Russian forces will withdraw from the nuclear plant. Moscow denied these claims and stated that the nuclear plant remains under Russian control and has no plans to withdraw from Enerhodar and abandon the nuclear plant.

US-EU alliance heading for 'ugly divorce' – ex-Russian president

Washington cheats on its partner, which lacks the resolve to break up, Dmitry Medvedev has said

The "marriage" between the US and EU will likely end in divorce, following the obvious "economic cheating" by the American "alpha-male," former Russian President Dmitry Medvedev has said. The remarks were

made on Monday amid media reports that EU nations are becoming increasingly angry over what they see as American opportunism amid the Ukraine crisis.

The US “has no intention to share his income. On the contrary, he steals the last savings of his aging partner and pockets the money without any qualms,” Medvedev, the deputy head of Russia’s Security Council, wrote on his Telegram channel.

Washington increasingly makes the business conditions at home attractive to European companies and encourages other nations to buy its products, he noted. Meanwhile, the market for European goods is shrinking, in part because of its decision to decouple from Russia, he added.

“You can’t really trust those rich patrons. Just like that – Europe is off the allowance!” he said. The EU could *“break up with its cheating ... partner and start a new life of freedom,”* but most likely they do not have enough resolve and *“testosterone”* for it, he added. In a nod to *“political correctness,”* Medvedev said he declined to define the genders of the characters in his metaphor.

The growing rift between EU leaders and their American counterparts has been reflected in public statements within the bloc and in Western media reports.

Last week, Politico described a growing anger in the EU due to the perception that Washington is profiting from the crisis among the member states. Some of the bloc’s senior officials are irritated by the fact that US energy suppliers are selling liquified natural gas to EU nations at a price four times higher than at home, while military contractors are benefitting by *“selling more weapons”* to Ukraine, the article said.

EU officials also point to the US Inflation Reduction Act and the impact that the financial incentives for eco-friendly businesses that it provides will have on European companies trying to compete, and which are finding it difficult to cope with the record-high energy prices at home, Politico added. <https://www.rt.com/russia/567325-medvedev-us-eu-marriage/>

FTX implosion claims another crypto victim

BlockFi has become the latest casualty following the collapse of the major cryptocurrency exchange

Leading cryptocurrency lender and financial services firm BlockFi filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection on Monday, becoming the latest company in the industry affected by the collapse of major crypto exchange FTX.

In the filing with the US Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey, the company said it had more than 100,000 creditors, with liabilities and assets ranging from \$1 billion to \$10 billion.

“BlockFi looks forward to a transparent process that achieves the best outcome for all clients and other stakeholders,” stated Mark Renzi from Berkeley Research Group, which serves as BlockFi’s financial adviser.

In June, the now-defunct FTX crypto exchange agreed to provide the company with a \$400 million credit line. BlockFi’s chief executive, Zac Prince, then said the loan would provide *“access to capital that further bolsters our balance sheet.”* The deal gave FTX the option to buy BlockFi.

The agreement also meant that BlockFi was financially entangled with FTX, which has itself filed for bankruptcy this month after a series of revelations about mishandled customer funds and abandoned acquisition plans by rival exchange Binance. A few days after the exchange collapsed, BlockFi suspended withdrawals, explaining that it had *“significant exposure”* to FTX, including undrawn amounts from its credit line and assets.

The New Jersey-based BlockFi was created in 2017 and as of last year claimed more than 450,000 retail clients who could obtain loans in minutes, without credit checks. <https://www.rt.com/business/567334-ftx-crypto-bankrupt-blockfi/>

The Israel Air Force this week will hold one of its largest drills in years with the United States Air Force simulating offensive strikes against Iran’s nuclear program.

The drill will take place from Tuesday until Thursday over the Mediterranean Sea and Israel. It will include long-range flights such as those that Israeli pilots might need to make in order to reach the Islamic Republic.

The exercise will include refuelers as well as fighter jets from both forces.

Tensions between Israel and Iran remain high

Iran, which possesses over 1,000 short- and medium-range ballistic missiles, continues to smuggle weapons to countries and non-state actors such as Hezbollah, which is estimated to have an arsenal of some 50,000 missiles on Israel's northern border.

With tensions high over Iran's nuclear program and regional hostility, Israel and the Islamic Republic have been threatening each other with senior officers stating that their militaries are capable of striking the other.

Israel has significantly increased its readiness level and has taken steps throughout the past year to prepare a credible military option against Iran's nuclear facilities.

The NIS 58 billion defense budget set for the IDF in the coming year is expected to allow the Israeli military to focus on the threats posed by Iran across the region, with some NIS 3.5b. designated specifically for this.

The upcoming drill was discussed by [IDF Chief of Staff Lt.-Gen. Aviv Kohavi during his visit to Washington](#) last week. Kohavi, who returned to Israel a day earlier than planned following a deadly double bombing in Jerusalem, met with senior American officials including Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Gen. Mark Milley, and CENTCOM Commander Gen. Michael Kurilla.

In the last year, the [IDF and CENTCOM](#) forces have held several joint drills as well as operational missions. Kurilla was in Israel a week prior to Kohavi's visit and toured the northern border as well as the IAF's fleet of [F-35 Adir stealth fighter jets](#).

"We are operating together on all fronts to gather intelligence, neutralize threats, and prepare for various scenarios in either one or multiple arenas," Kohavi said during Kurilla's visit, adding that the two countries were "developing joint military capabilities at an accelerated rate" against Iran and other threats in the Middle East.

Outgoing Defense Minister Benny Gantz told reporters at the beginning of the month that while [Israel has the capabilities to strike Iran's nuclear facilities](#), Prime Minister-designate Benjamin Netanyahu must consider the issue "carefully" before giving the order.

"Israel has the ability to act in Iran. We have the readiness, development capabilities, and long-term plans we are managing. We need to prepare for this possibility, and we will also need to consider this issue very carefully before carrying it out," he said.

Iran publishes list of 'sensitive' sites in Israel to strike in future war

Iran's list of "sensitive" sites includes the Knesset, government buildings, warehouses, facilities and institutions.

Under the guise of reporting on reports by Beirut-based Al Mayadeen, a pan-Arabist satellite news channel, media outlets close to the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) have published a list of “sensitive” sites that could be targeted in a future war. The reports listed a number of buildings and sites in Israel in what was clearly intended as a threat.

Iran’s Tasnim News Agency on Monday reported: “In this regard, Al Mayadeen network has published a report on the analysis of Israel’s target bank and the sensitive positions of this regime that can be targeted in any war. At the beginning of this report, the general situation of the Zionist regime at the military level and its equipment has been examined.”

The article included a list of sites in Israel, such as the Knesset, the Prime Minister’s Office and the Defense Ministry. It included what Tasnim characterized as “nuclear sites and facilities.” In the list of “warehouses” and facilities, the report included a [Rafael Advanced Defense Systems](#) site in Haifa, the Weizmann Institute of Science in Rehovot and the Technion-Israel Institute of Technology in Haifa.

The report also examined “airports and military and intelligence bases.” It mentioned “civilian” airports, such as Ben-Gurion Airport and Ramon Airport near Eilat. A list of military bases followed.

This appears to be one of the few times that Iranian media close to the regime have so openly published what it claims is a list of Israeli sites that could be targeted in a future war. This appears to point to Iran and its proxies’ estimates of their targeting ability.

In the last conflict with Hamas, the terrorist group claimed to have targeted Ramon Airport. Operations at the airport were briefly suspended during that conflict. Hamas also appeared to target other sites that have infrastructure, using large-scale salvos of rockets to try to overwhelm the Iron Dome air-defense system.

[Hezbollah](#) has also made threats regarding targeting Israel’s infrastructure, including threatening gas rigs off the coast and industrial sites near Haifa.

What does Iran mean for this list to do?

The overall context of Iran can be seen as merely bragging and threatening. But it also illustrates the shift in thinking in Tehran and among Iran’s proxy groups. The proxies include Hezbollah, Islamic Jihad, the Houthis in Yemen and members of Hashd al-Shaabi in Iraq.

Recent reports that an Iranian IRGC member linked to Iran’s drone program was killed in Syria, and that Iran wants to move air-defense systems to Syria, show Iran’s possible concerns regarding these latest tensions and threats.

Publishing the kind of list that Iran’s pro-regime media published on Monday, listing sites that Iran thinks are sensitive, can be seen as a [message to Israel](#). It can also be seen as illustrating that Tehran believes the conflict with Israel is entering a strategic stage in which Iran would like to supply proxy groups in Lebanon and Syria with more advanced weapons, including drones and precision-guided munitions, that can target the sites Al Mayadeen listed.

Iran has increased its drone threats against Israel in recent years, and Tehran works closely with Hamas and Hezbollah to try to learn from past conflicts and tensions with Israel. <https://www.jpost.com/middle-east/iran-news/article-723541>

Thousands poised to rush southern US border – media

People are reportedly massing in Mexico and awaiting the expiration of a law that streamlined the removal of illegal migrants

Thousands of migrants are camped out on the south side of the US-Mexican border expecting the repeal of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s (CDC) Title 42, which allowed for the speedy removal of illegal immigrants on public health grounds, according to local media. The would-be immigrants reportedly plan to seek asylum en masse as soon as the order expires.

Border camps in locations like Juarez, Puerto Palomas, and Tijuana are bursting with migrants waiting for their chance to seek asylum in the US following the expiration of a Trump-era policy. It allowed immigration officials to turn away migrants at ports of entry or expel them back to their country of origin in order to prevent the spread of Covid-19. Some 14,000 migrants are waiting in Juarez alone, according to inewsourc, with a number shelters running at double capacity.

Title 42 was struck down earlier this month by US District Court Judge Emmet Sullivan, and the Biden administration did not contest the decision, instead merely requesting a five-week grace period to prepare for the resumption of asylum procedures.

While the measure was set to be repealed on December 21, 15 Republican-run states last week filed to keep it,

arguing doing away with the order would “directly harm” the states and the country in general. “Wherever those aliens end up, they will impose financial burdens on the states involuntarily hosting them,” the filing said, as reported by CNBC.

Earlier this year, Texas declared a state of emergency due to the unprecedented number of illegal aliens streaming across the border, and the governors of some border states have taken to busing migrants to Democrat-run “sanctuary cities” to force their leaders to confront the results of their policies.

A May estimate by the Department of Homeland Security predicted the repeal of Title 42 would result in as many as 18,000 migrants entering the US through its southern border every day. Rep. Andy Biggs predicted an even larger figure in April, telling reporters the border could see as many as 30,000 new arrivals every day.

Currently, Customs and Border Protection records at least 6,200 border-crossers daily on average.

Top oncologist: Cancer in patients exploding after COVID shots

'This must be aired and debated immediately'

The well-established link between the COVID-19 mRNA shots and blood clots, myocarditis, heart attacks and strokes is reason enough to stop the vaccine program, argues a London oncologist.

And further, the average age of death from COVID-19 in the United Kingdom is 82, which is higher than the age for all other causes, 81.

But there is another reason enough to halt the shots, wrote Dr. Angus Dalgleish, professor of Oncology at St. George's University of London, in a [letter to the British Medical Journal](#).

"As a practising oncologist I am seeing people with stable disease rapidly progress after being forced to have a booster, usually so they can travel," he wrote to the BMJ's editor in chief, Dr. Kamran Abba^{si}.

"Even within my own personal contacts I am seeing B cell-based disease after the boosters," he wrote. "They describe being distinctly unwell a few days to weeks after the booster – one developing leukaemia, two work colleagues Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, and an old friend who has felt like he has had Long Covid since receiving his booster and who, after getting severe bone pain, has been diagnosed as having multiple metastases from a rare B cell disorder."

Dalgleish said he has enough experience in the field "to know that these are not the coincidental anecdotes that many suggest, especially as the same pattern is being seen in Germany, Australia and the USA."

He said his observations fit the pattern observed around the world of innate immune suppression for several weeks after mRNA vaccination.

"All these patients to date have melanoma or B cell based cancers, which are very susceptible to immune control – and that is before the reports of suppressor gene suppression by mRNA in laboratory experiments."

Dalgleish concluded: "This must be aired and debated immediately."

A [recent study found a sharp rise in cancer](#) in people under 50.

Researchers at Brigham and Women's Hospital cited increases worldwide in cancer of the breast, colon, esophagus, kidney, liver and pancreas.

One of the nation's most prolific pathologists, Dr. Ryan Cole, has reported a significant rise in cancer cases in his Boise, Idaho, lab.

He has received data from oncologists indicating the mRNA vaccines disrupt the immune system. He said in an interview that physicians report "seeing the weirdest cancers, and cancers that we have been able to keep in check and treat, taking off like wildfire – going stage 2, stage 3, stage 4, just like that."

Meanwhile, a professor at MIT has [coauthored a paper](#) that found a 25% increase in heart attack emergency calls among young Israelis after the country's mRNA vaccine rollout.
