**Mirabilis September 2005 Convention Presents Global Initiatives**

A delegation of international executives came together from as far away as Hong Kong and Europa to participate in the launching of the global initiatives that will see Mirabilis as a Global 50 International Corporation by the year 2012.

Frank Amador provided the audience at The Holiday Center in Orlando, Florida, with an account of how his Mirabilis has come in its first year, confident with a plan of his vision for the next seven years. As apparent in revenues are, which Mirabilis anticipates will top the \$1 billion dollar mark this year; it is the vision and philosophy behind how our goals are accomplished that leads the methods used at Mirabilis.

"There is a right way and a wrong way to do business," said Mr. Amador. "And the right way includes revenue and prosperity in all aspects for all services. We are going to show the world how individuals can have personal wealth regardless of religion, racial and political differences."

The methodology, that provides greater revenues for individuals and other organizations involved in the network, comes from the removal of excess approach factors. While it will continue to have individuals wondering at how this "magic" is performed, every individual from a server in an Alaska restaurant to the brother of an executive in Alaska, will have the opportunity to submit potential projects and enjoy the benefits of lifelong commitment. Benefits such as these will lead to a better number of individuals that won't have a need for governmental social security systems.

"We have collated the core portable network that will set as the foundation to show the world how it can be accomplished in practice," Amador stated.

The Mirabilis Initiatives, when completed, will make Mirabilis the private employer of a Fortune 500 Company by January 2006.

**Mirabilis Ventures Acquires New Florida Industrial Electric**

Mirabilis has recently acquired the Central Florida-based **New Florida Industrial Electric, Inc. (NFE)**. Mirabilis obtained 75% of the company's ownership for \$5-million plus a \$1-million line of credit. The remaining 25% of NFE was funded with current president Conrad Elegante, who secured an additional \$1 million in both bank and a line of credit through a corporate bank.

"Mirabilis will be able to help NFE obtain better bonding capabilities, which will in turn increase the company's work in progress," said Mirabilis Construction Portfolio veteran Vicki Miller. "We expect NFE's backlog to at least double and possibly even triple in the next six months. Also, NFE is a perfect fit for Mirabilis' strategic plan of acquiring companies that have substantial human resources bases and we can offer the company employee better benefits at better rates through our resources."

"Our Florida Industrial Electric Team is excited to partner with Mirabilis Ventures," said NFE President Conrad Elegante. "Both Florida Industrial Electric and Mirabilis make our employees are our most important asset. Joining our teams will no doubt enable us to further enhance our ability to grow as businesses and as a preferred employer."

### Nexia Opens New Regional Office in Detroit, Michigan



### Mirabilis and ISI come to the Aid of Hurricane Katrina Victims

Mirabilis Ventures, Inc. and its Naples, FL-based Administrative Services Organization (Payroll Concepts) — the benefits administration arm — Vice President of Mirabilis Ventures, Inc. Luisa Andrei, along with other volunteers from Southwest FL, have spent countless hours denoting, loading and packaging 52-ft long semi-tractor trailers with much-needed items that are being sent to the storm-ravaged area. The convoys of trucks, donated by American Farms, were stocked with supplies such as logistics and over-the-counter medical supplies, food, water, A/C units and cleaning items. The food and funds will be used to supply the rescue workers who have been tirelessly working 20-hour shifts with their first hour


"Most of these rescue workers and victims have been sleeping in what is left of a hot garage for safety, and they of course have no air conditioning or supplies," said Andrei. "Their rural inland areas are struggling because federal aid and support just can't get to all of these people and we felt we needed to get them some help quickly with the use of our combined resources. We just want to do our part to help these people recover and rebuild. So far, we've been able to feed thousands of people with the donated supplies."

With help from Costco, Home Depot, the Marine Corp League, the Lee and Collier County Sheriff's Office and a sizable donation check from Mirabilis Ventures, volunteers were able to quickly and efficiently load pallets of supplies on the convoy of trucks for delivery. Among the supplies are the backpacks and school supplies, in hopes that these supplies can help the mayor of Waveland reach his goal of getting the children back in school by October 1, 2005.

In addition to the donation of these physical supplies to victims, Mirabilis and its wholly-owned Information Technology subsidiary Information Systems, Inc. (ISI) are partnering with MCi and Rescues International to provide telecommunications and Internet services to Gulf Coast areas affected by Hurricane Katrina at no charge. The project is called Light the Cities.

The ISI team is focused on assisting the local and state authorities with re-establishing communications to the world, and our target is to provide carrier-grade wireless Internet and voice over IP telephone services all the way from Baton Rouge, LA to Biloxi, MS," said ISI President James Vanderveen. "The services will start in the next few days and the team will travel entirely towards Waveland, Mississippi where they will meet up with the Mobile Command Center from Orange County, Florida Sheriff's office before moving across the I-10 corridor to Biloxi. We're going to help these people get back on track with their lives, once again."

ISI is funding half a million dollars for this project, and companies such as T3 Wireless Inc., Astro Communications and ICS Technologies are providing equipment and services. ISI is setting up a special account that will be responsible to distribute and manage funds for this project.
