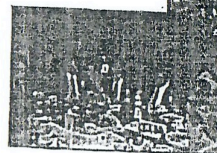

The methodology, that provides greater revenues for affiliates and other organizations involved in the network, comes from the removal of "arrest" expense factors. While it will continue to leave outsiders wondering at how this "magic" is performed, every individual from a server in an internet restaurant to the brother of an executive in Alaska, will have the opportunity to submit potential projects and enjoy the benefits of big-dog connections. Benefits such as these will lead to a greater

number of individuals that won't have a need for governmental social security systems.

"We have established the core portfolio network that will set us the foundation to show the world how it can be accomplished in practice," Anadon stated.

The Mirabilis initiatives, when completed, "will make Mirabilis the private equivalent of a Fortune 500 Company by January 2006."



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Mirabilis Ventures Acquires New Florida Industrial Electric

Mirabilis has recently acquired the Central Florida-based New Florida Industrial Electric, Inc. (NFI). Mirabilis obtained 75% of the company's ownership for \$5 million, plus a \$1 million fee of credit. The company's ownership, 75% of NFI will remain with current president Conrad Spemann, who secured an additional \$1 million in both hard and a line of credit through a corporate bank.

"Mirabilis will be able to help NFI obtain better bonding capabilities, which will in turn increase the company's work in progress," said Mirabilis Construction Portfolio veteran Vance Feller. "We expect NFI's business to grow, but doubt it will grow as fast as the next six months. benefits at better rates through our resources."

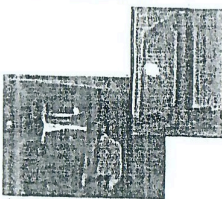

Mirabilis and ISI come to the Aid of Hurricane Katrina Victims

Mirabilis Ventures, Inc. and its Naples, FL-based Administrative Services Organization (Payroll Concepts) – the benefits administration arm of Mirabilis – have been Resource Partners, in helping a hand to Hurricane Katrina victims and rescue workers in the Waveband, Mississippi area. Vice President of Mirabilis Ventures, Inc. Laura Andrea, along with other volunteers with truck needed items that are being sent to the storm ravaged area. The convoys of trucks, donated by American Farms, were stacked with supplies such as hygiene and over-the-counter medical supplies, food, gifts, a/c units and cleaning items. The food and gifts will be used to supply the rescue workers who have been tirelessly working 20-hour shifts with their first hour meal in nearly two weeks.

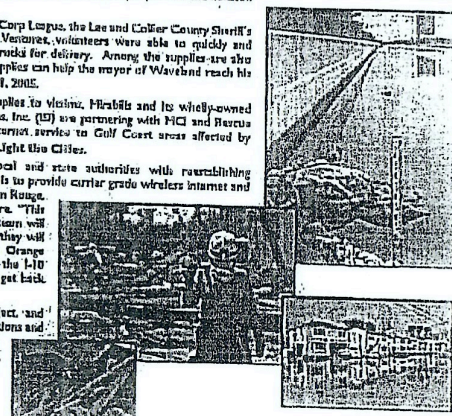
"Most of these rescue workers and victims have been sleeping in what is left of a hot garage for safety, and they of course have no air conditioning or supplies," said Andrea. "These rural inland areas are struggling because federal aid and support just can't get to all of these people and we felt you needed to get them some help quickly with the use of our combined resources. We just want to do our part to help these people recover and rebuild. So far, we've been able to feed thousands of people with the donated supplies."

With help from Corcoran, Home Depot, the Marine Corp League, the Lee and Collier County Sheriff's Office and a sizable donation check from Mirabilis Ventures, volunteers were able to quickly and efficiently load pallets of supplies on the convey of trucks for delivery. Among the supplies are also backpacks and school supplies, in hopes that these supplies can help the mayor of Waveband reach his goal of getting the children back in school by October 1, 2005.

In addition to the donation of these physical supplies to victims, Mirabilis and its wholly-owned Information technology subsidiary Information Systems, Inc. (ISI) are partnering with MCI and Narcom International to provide telecommunication and Internet services to Gulf Coast areas affected by Hurricane Katrina at no charge. The project is called Light the Cities.

"The ISI team is focused on assisting the local and state authorities with reestablishing communications to the outside world, and our target is to provide carrier grade wireless Internet and voice over IP telephone services all the way from Baton Rouge, LA to Bilal, MS," said ISI President James Vandewater. "This service will start within the next few days and the team will travel steadily towards Waveband, Mississippi where they will meet up with the Mobile Command Center from Orange County, Florida. Sheriff's office before moving across the I-10 corridor to Bilal. We're going to help these people get back on track with their lives, once again."

ISI is funding half a million dollars for the project, and companies such as T3 Wireless Inc., Alot Communications and ICS Technology are providing equipment and services. ISI is setting up a special account that will be responsible to distribute and manage funds for this project.
