Message from Nick Cooper - 1st VP/Caravan

Though we remain in recess due to COVID, we don't remain inactive in planning trips for next year. At this time we have trips planned to Buckskin Mountain State Park (Lake Havasu) for March 20-24 and to Dead Horse Ranch State Park (Cottonwood) for 4/11-15. Mark your calendars accordingly.

Due to the popularity of Buckskin Mountain we were only able to secure 18 sites, however, we will be monitoring the Park's site to see if we can get more between now and next year. Chris and I will Wagon Master Lake Havasu with Bob and Gale Hale's able assistance.

For DHR we were able to secure 25 sites on the same loop. We need someone to step up to take on the Wagon Master and Asst Wagon Master roles for DHR.

DHR is a great park contiguous to the city of Cottonwood. The city has an interesting "Old Town" with 5 winery tasting rooms, antique shops and restaurants. The Park has an extensive trail system for hikes, 3 large ponds for boating and fishing, and the Verde River runs through it. Jerome sits on the hill above Cottonwood, and the Tuzigoot National Monument is just around the corner. Red Rock State Park with Ranger led hikes is nearby and the same road to there is the back way into Sedona. Plenty to do.
