

RV Compound Update

This update is submitted by Sun City RV Club representatives Tim Barber, Bob McKay, and Gary Tayar who currently serve on the Sun City RV Compound Board of Directors.

It's been busy at the compound as you have probably noticed. Following are some of the recent improvements:

- Because the air line coming from the shop started leaking (due to old age) and had to be abandoned, a new shed was constructed where electricity was available one lane over from its old site.
- Staff is working on moving the water to the same site in the near future.
- Paving has been completed with only crack sealing and seal coating remaining to be done later this spring. For long term, chip sealing will be all that will be necessary to keep the roads in good shape.
- The office has under gone several upgrades which include a new roof, carpet replacement and new
 office furniture.
- In an effort to continue to provide the best RV storage, at the annual meeting in February the Board of Directors announced a fee change that will go into effect this year (see below). This change will be the first increase since 2011 and was agreed upon after researching all alternatives to make sure that by making this change the best possible long term security and services are provided.
