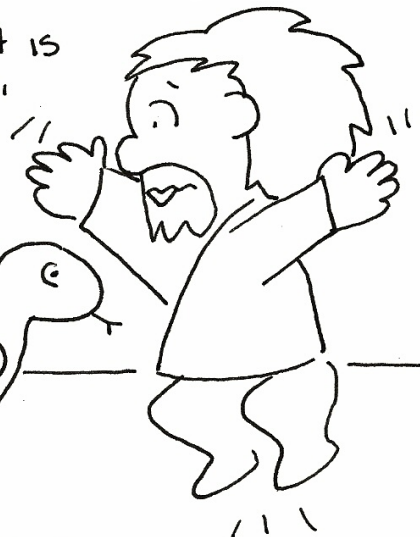


# Exodus 4

Then Moses said, "What if they will not believe me or listen to what I say?" v1

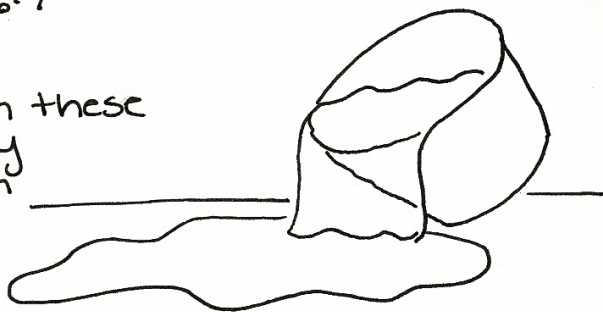
The Lord said to him, "What is that in your hand?" And he said, "A staff."

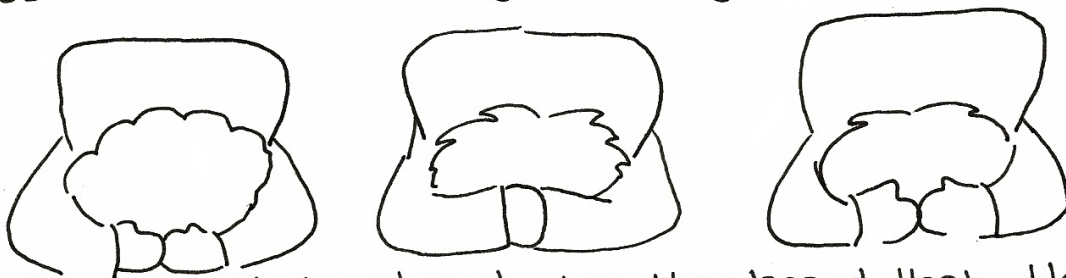

"If they will not believe even these two signs or heed what you say then you shall take some water from the Nile and pour it on the... ground... the water... will become blood" v9



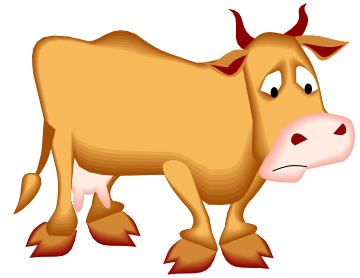
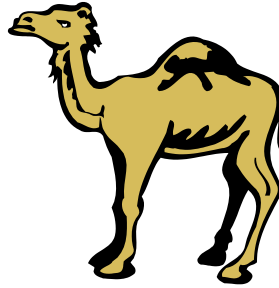

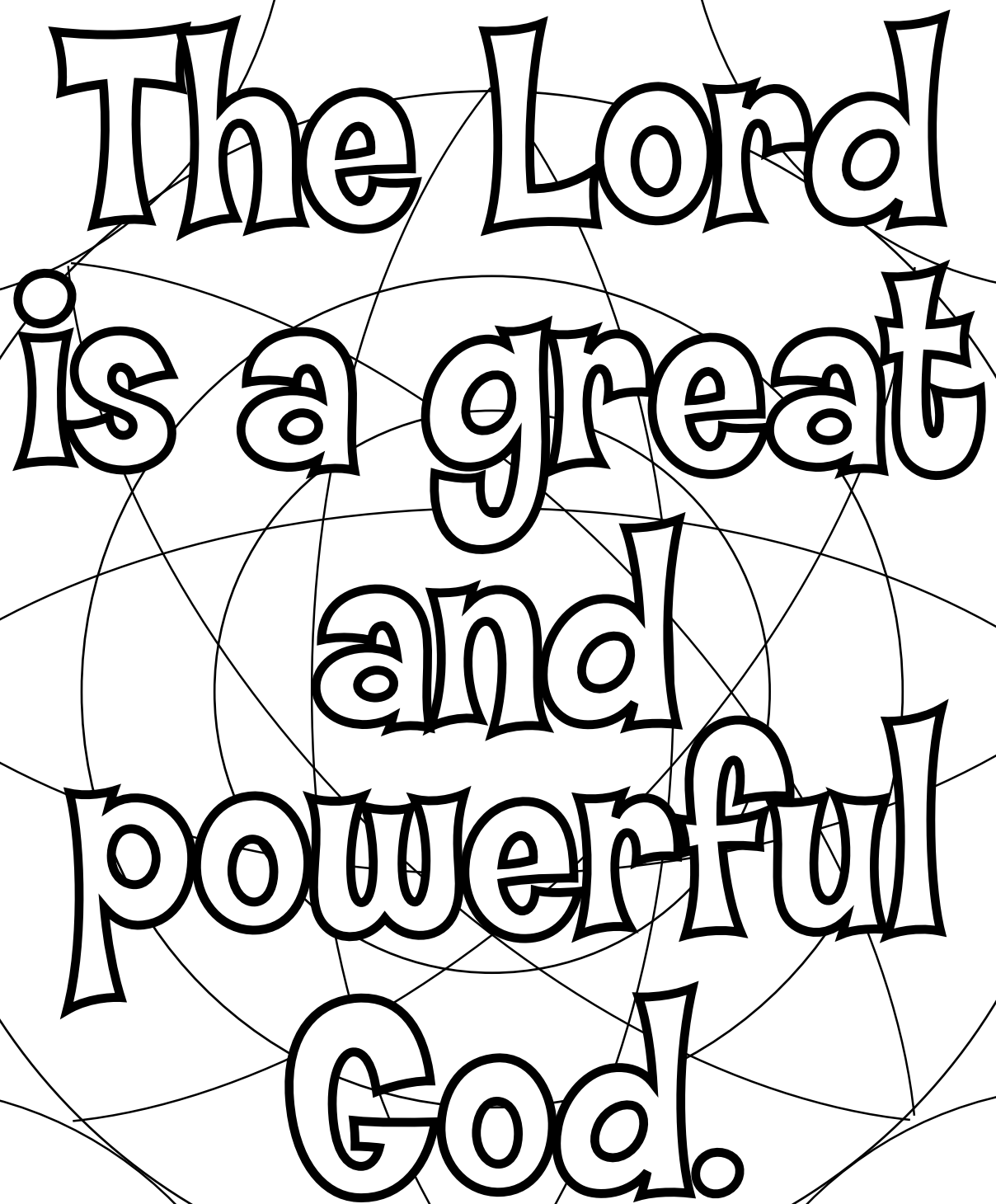
## "What is that in Your Hand?" Exodus 4:2
