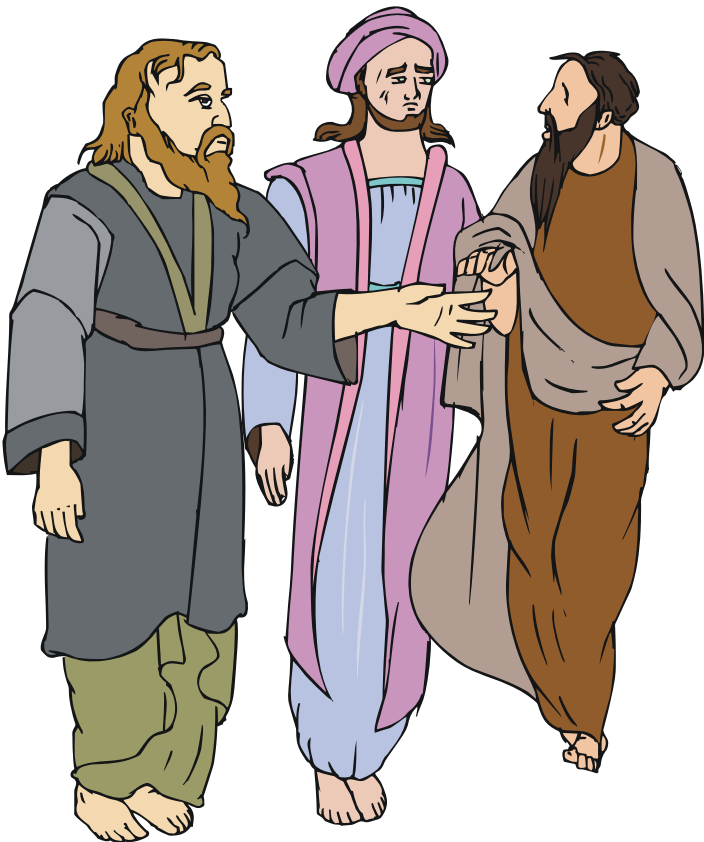
# On the Road to Emmaus

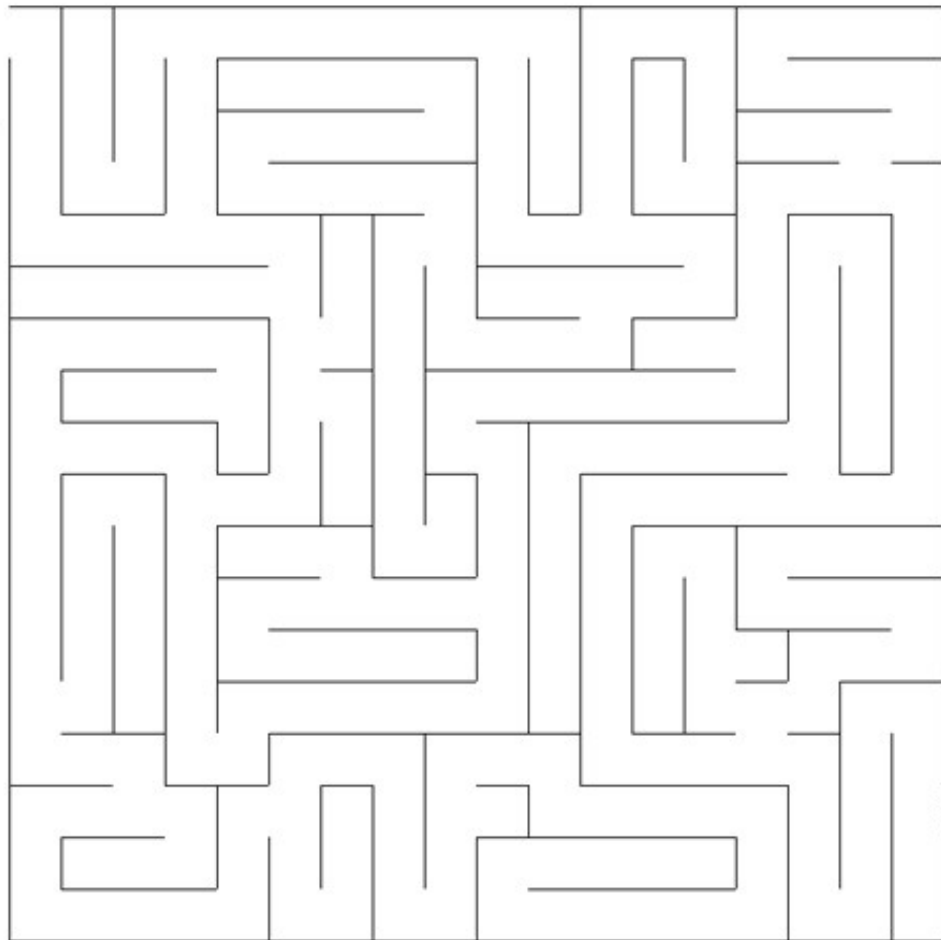

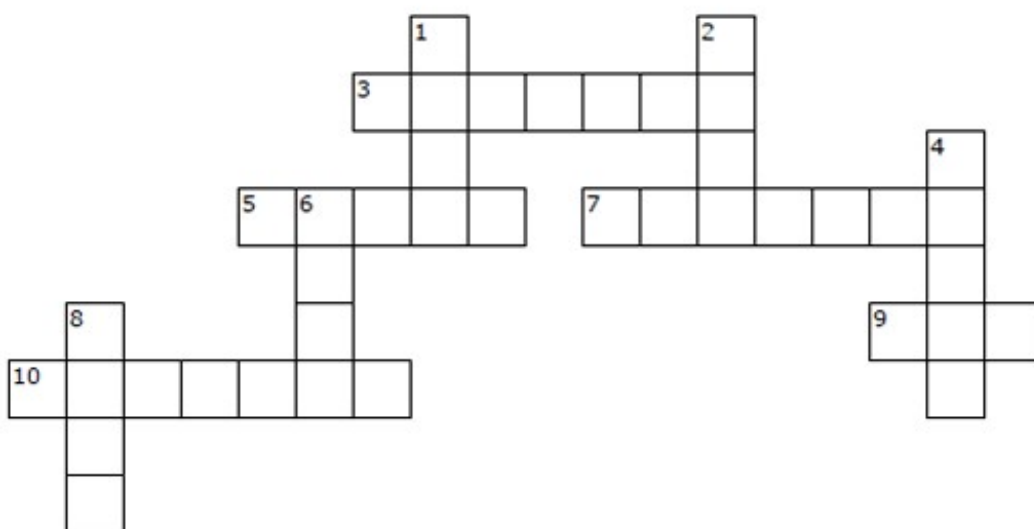
