¹ Booth dimensions may vary based on market layout. A diagram will be available on November 15th showing artist placement. Attendance at the pre show meeting is extremely important to learn about booth placement, shop procedures and shift expectations.

² Artists may also work additional show hours but only the required work shifts will have commission waved via the main checkout. Artists are welcome to ring customer purchases themselves without paying MAC commission.

³ A fee will be deducted from artists' sales for missing a shift or arriving late for a shift. 1st offense \$25, 2nd \$50... doubling for each additional offense. The shift signup sheet will be available electronically at move-in.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Final Deadline ----- November 12th or until sold out

- For members, acceptance is automatic if registration is complete, and fees are paid in full by the application deadline. Your space will not be reserved until fees are paid in full. For those paying by credit/debit card, we will send you a payment link by email soon after receiving your application. After you have submitted your application, text Don at 901-603-5155.
- For non-members, acceptance into the Holiday Show is subject to a jury process. You will need to provide five or more pictures representative of your work (email them to Don Rockhoundfromms@gmail.com). Notification of application status will be made via e-mail no later than November 13th. If accepted, an invoice will be included and must be paid in full as soon as possible and no later than November 14th.
- Each artist within a booth must complete an application and be accepted on the same terms as the primary booth owner. Booths shared by two artists are subject to the small booth fee. More than two artists in a booth require special approval and must have work that appears cohesive.

SHOW OPERATION

- This year we will have a silent auction benefiting **<u>The Miracle League of Memphis</u>**. Each artist is asked to donate an item to the silent auction. Brian Manness will be the artist contact for the charity.
- The show is operated as a retail "store," meaning there will be staff available to make sales, assist customers, etc. Packaging for items, i.e. bags and tissue paper, is provided for the sales that are run through the general check out. It is expected that artists selling their work directly from their booth will be responsible for their own packaging (wrapping, bags, etc.). An additional fee will be added at the organizers' discretion for those who fail to follow this policy consistently.
- Advertising will be done via a variety of media outlets including the Memphis Flyer, radio interviews, direct mail, etc. Artists are expected to participate in word-of-mouth advertising, and to mail post cards to your mailing lists either electronically or via USPS. Artists will be notified when the postcards are available and will be provided with electronic postcards and/or logos that may be used.
- Merchandise must be handmade. Handmade can include mixed media with upcycled items. No massproduced merchandise (i.e... items available on Amazon, etc.) will be permitted. Items not meeting these criteria will be removed from booths and the artist may be asked to leave the show with no refund being given. (Please note one current member is grandfathered in to sell vintage goods, but others are not permitted to do so.)
- Electricity will be provided to each booth. Artists may bring their own lighting and are encouraged to show their holiday spirit.
- Artists are expected to keep their booths stocked and clean throughout the show. Inattention to this
 reflects poorly on the entire show and can lead to not being invited back next year. Artists are asked
 to restock and hang art during slow times, not midday on Saturdays and Sundays.
- All items must be clearly marked with the price and artists' name/business name and the three-letter code. If you are not sure what your code is, ask Don. Descriptions and item numbers are also encouraged. In the event an item is unpriced/unmarked, the Organizers reserve the right to either refuse a sale, or to make an informed guess as to the cost of the item.

- Artists are welcome to discount items only if the price tag on the item has been updated to reflect the new price. % off without a calculated sale price is not acceptable.
- Sales of art by your neighbor artists to avoid paying checkout commission is not permitted and can lead to not being invited back next year.
- Artists are always expected to act professionally. If a customer is present, please acknowledge them
 and refrain from complaining about others, discussing politics or religion, and using foul language in
 front of them. We do not want to offend our customers or make them feel uncomfortable while
 shopping.
- All sales handled by Memphis Arts Collective will be charged with current state sales tax. Sales tax will be remitted to the State of Tennessee by Memphis Arts Collective.
- We will accept cash, checks and credit cards. The organizers will take every precaution but are not liable for bad checks or credit cards.
- The organizers will carry general liability insurance. The Holiday Show Organizers will take all
 reasonable precautions but will not be responsible for losses due to fire, theft, breakage, flood, acts of
 God, bad checks, or credit card issues. We encourage artists to insure their own work.
- Two checks will be issued to artists as follows:

December 12th ------ For sales from 11/24/2023 through 12/07/2023 less commissions and not cleared checks/charges. Available for pick up at the show along with an inventory of sales

December 26th ------ For sales from 12/08/2023 through 12/24/2023 less commissions and not cleared checks/charges. Available for pick up at the show breakdown along with an inventory of sales

- The undersigned does hereby discharge, release, and hold harmless the Memphis Arts Collective and all persons involved in the organization and operation of said businesses for any loss and/or damages to the exhibitor's person or property before, during or after the Market.
- The undersigned agrees that the information submitted for selection is representative of the work to be sold, that all wares offered for sale are hand-made by the artist and that none of the wares for sale were purchased by the artist and brought here for resale. The criteria used to determine "hand-crafted" will be at the discretion of the show organizers and the Collective reserves the right to request removal of any items which in its sole judgment does not meet the quality presented for selection, work considered to be in poor taste, or items not representative of work submitted during the application process. The collective also reserves the right to ask artists in violation of this policy to leave the show with no refund being given.
- The undersigned agrees that all sales made through the Collective Store, which includes use of bags, wrapping material and credit card machine will be subject to stated commissions.
- The undersigned agrees to participate in the Collective Store by working shifts. A fee will be deducted from artists' sales for missing a shift or arriving late for a shift. 1st offense \$25, 2nd \$50... doubling for each additional offense.
