2.The Tribulation Judgments

During the seven years of tribulation, evil people will bring various calamities upon the earth, and God will pour out severe judgment on the earth. These devastating events are introduced by the seals, the trumpets, and the vials (Revelation 6; 8; 9; 15; 16).

During this time the people of the earth will go through a time of suffering and death such as the world has never known.

a.The Seals (Revelation 6; 8:1)

The seals describe the following events:

- (1)An evil leader who is usually called the Antichrist will win the world to himself.
- (2)Terrible war will come, followed by famine and death.
- (3)One-fourth of the world's population will die... this is page 156 in the link above and in page 157 he talks about a meteor...
- 4)There will be much persecution of people who turn to God during this time.
- (5)Catastrophic earthquakes will disturb the earth.
- (6)The moon will become as blood, and people will hide in the mountains for fear.

b.The Trumpets (Revelation 8–9)

- (1)During these judgments hail will fall, and fire will burn over a third of the earth.
- (2)A falling meteor will fall on one-third of the rivers.

One of the good things about the book of the revelations is that the church disappears in chapter 4 and five it doesn't appear again until chapter 19! We escape the tribulation!

One of the good things about the book of John in the Gospels is that chapter 12 shows where there's a holy place of worship. Judas which means praise was in charge of the bag of praise so the love of Money took the place of Jesus and his love. Is Jesus inside your bag of praise still? Who do you love more- money, or Jesus, by Whom all things were made and we by Him? The poor we will always have, but do you still have Jesus? Are you willing to go to the Holy of holies with him to the tomb of baptism in John 21 where an Angel is at the head and another angel is at the foot and let the blood be applied to your mercy seat?
