ABCD 4-Man Las Vegas Scramble (Las Vegas Scramble)

Foursome vs. Field – 75% H.I. – 2 Best Net Balls – Two drives needed per player

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins – Flights set by ABCD player status

Four-man teams are determined by blind draw. Four-man team format that combines a scramble tee shot with individual stroke play. All players tee off, the best tee shot is selected, and all team members play their own ball from that spot until holed. Lowest 2 net balls scored as the team score. Individual gross skins game in effect.

Spring Individual (Individual Stroke Play)

Player vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Low Gross + Net Payout

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

Individual tournaments are the most basic form of tournament play. Players record their hole-by-hole scores on the scorecard and simply add their total strokes at the end of each round, and the player with the lowest net score wins. Top gross score is awarded in each flight.

Front Tee Scramble (Scramble)

Pair vs. Flight – 50% H.I.

Pair vs. Flight Gross Skins

Two-man team with 50% handicap reduction. Each player will play from the front or red tee boxes, whichever is closer to the green. Will utilize the best shot until ball is holed.

ADO Albuquerque Open (Individual Stroke Play)

Player vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Low Gross + Net Payout

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

This tournament is open to any individual with an established handicap in the greater Albuquerque area. Individual tournaments are the most basic form of tournament play. Players record their hole-by-hole scores on the scorecard and simply add their total strokes at the end of each round, and the player with the lowest net score wins. Top gross score is awarded in each flight.

Member/Guest Shootout (True Alternate Shot 9 Hole Shoot Out)

Pair vs. Field – No Handicap Elimination-style Tournament – Cash Payout

All two-man teams start on the first hole on the Dam Nine with the highest scorer eliminated after each hole, continuing until one winner remains. Team will utilize the true alternate shot format. Players should decide beforehand who will hit the first shot and then they alternate every shot from there on. When one teammate makes the putt, his partner hits the drive on the next hole. No player hits two consecutive shots. Ties are broken by a chip-off at the end of each hole.

Member/Guest Day 1 (Fourball)

Pair vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Best Net Ball

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

Often called best ball, two-man teams compete with each player playing their own ball throughout the round. The lower individual net score of the partners is recorded as the team score for that hole.

Member/Guest Day 2 (Shamble)

Pair vs. Flight – 75% H.I. – Both Net Balls

Pair vs. Flight Teams Gross Skins

Often called Las Vegas Scramble, two-man team format that combines a scramble tee shot with individual stroke play. All players tee off, the best tee shot is selected, and all team members play their own ball from that spot until holed.

President's Cup Net Championship (Individual Stroke Play)

Player vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Net Payout

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

This two-day tournament determines our net handicap champion for the Men's Association. Lowest net score across all flights is the champion.

Club Championship (Individual Stroke Play)

Player vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Low Gross + Net Payout

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

Must play from the blue tees to be considered Club Champion. Only gross scores are counted for this blue flight. The other net flights are paid out by low gross and multiple top net spots.

4-man Irish Scramble (Individual Stroke Play)

Foursome vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Team Net Payout

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

Each player on the team plays their own ball throughout the round. As the round progresses multiple net balls are counted toward the team score. Holes 1-6 will have one net ball counted. Holes 7-12 will have two net balls counted and holes 13-18 will have three net balls counted.

2-man Six Shooter (Multiple Formats)

Pair vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Holes 1-6 – Net Best Ball

35% + 15% H.I. – Holes 7-12 – Scramble

50% H.I. of Sum – Holes 13-18 – Alternate Shot with Alternate Drives

Pair vs. Flight Gross Skins – All Balls Count for Holes 1-6

Fall Individual (Individual Stroke Play)

Player vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Low Gross + Net Payout

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

Individual tournaments are the most basic form of tournament play. Players record their hole-by-hole scores on the scorecard and simply add their total strokes at the end of each round, and the player with the lowest net score wins. Top gross score is awarded in each flight.

Season Finale (Individual Stroke Play)

Player vs. Flight – 100% H.I. – Low Gross + Net Payout

Player vs. Flight Gross Skins

Player of the Year points are worth twice the normal amount. Players record their hole-by-hole scores on the scorecard and simply add their total strokes at the end of each round, and the player with the lowest net score wins. Top gross score is awarded in each flight.
