MONTHLY MINUTES -- MAY 14TH, 2019 6:30 P.M.

**** 6:30 P.M.** Meeting called to order by Chairman Tony Kautza.

**** Minutes:** Minutes from April 16th, 2019 meeting read and accepted after correction to book audit – changed insisted to stated. Motion from Pete; seconded by Scott; passed and correction made.

**** Public Comments or Concerns:** None.

**** Monthly Expenditures:** Signed and approved.

**** Budget:** Approved per motion from Scott; seconded by Pete; passed.

**** Roads Report:** All roads graded; Red Granite is in bad shape; weight limits down; ditching done; culverts need work; stop sign stolen; posts have been purchased for fire numbers.

**** Old Business:**

- 1) Road abandonment: Clerk given land description and asked to type up abandonment letters.
- 2) Book Audit: Prices for audit would be between \$6,000 and \$8,000. Tabled at this time.
- 3) ATV/UTV signage: Sign costs presented to board. Chairman is aware of procedures needed to open roads.

**** New Business:**

- 1) Website: Dick Lehmann given thank-you for his service. He explained new hosting plans that Valerie Parker will be using. Presented bill for this site and it should be paid up for two years.
- 2) Truck loan: Loan papers have been filled out and sent to Freightline.
- 3) Old truck: Truck displayed for sale; Jack Kautza and Langlade County have displayed interest. \$40,000 price.
- 4) Road gravel: Jack Kautza will be loading and hauling granite for road work that will be starting next week. Granite will be purchased from Peterson for \$4.40 per yard.
- 5) Pressure washer: Will be picked up this week.
- 6) Culverts: Rick will be marking culverts with PVC pipe.
- 7) Tow strap: Tabled
- 8) Easton brooming: Brooming was done and our township will help the Town of Easton with future projects to work off cost of this project.
- 9) Concrete front of Town Hall: Concrete has leveled some. Jack Kautza suggested insulation be put under it; pavers also suggested.
- 10) Fire department bill: Clerk advised to send it to the County – not to pay it.
